Disease Awareness

Awareness program on 'conjunctivitis' was conducted at the Department of Botany and Microbiology on 12 th August 2023. B.Sc. and M.Sc. participated in the activity. Dr. Femina Sobin delivered a lecture on various precautionary measures to avoid conjunctivitis, followed by Pictionary competition; through which, the dos and don'ts relevant to conjunctivitis were picturized. In the next phase of the programme, in order to create awareness on 'conjunctivitis,' the Pictionary were displayed and explained by the students at various locations in and outside college campus.

Slogan Competition

Plantation program

With an aim of increasing greenery in the college campus, an eco-friendly move through Rose plantation was organized by the Department in collaboration with Nature Club on 30th October 2023. More than 180 rose plants was planted in the college campus.

Awareness programme on sustainable farming

A workshop on Sustainable Agriculture Practices was organized by The Nature Club In association with Department of Botany and Microbiology, on 18th August 2023. Dr. Rajendra Sahu, Assistant Professor, Department of Agronomy, JNKVV, Dr. Femina Sobin and Dr. Manju Dixit, Assistant Professor, St. Aloysius College, were the speakers of the session. The students were briefed about the details about the sustainable agriculture practices, its history, and future prospects, and gained an insight about irrigation techniques, integrated pest management and

advantages of sustainable farming, Modern agricultural practices and their benefits. A demonstration of how to prepare Vermicomposting was given to students.
