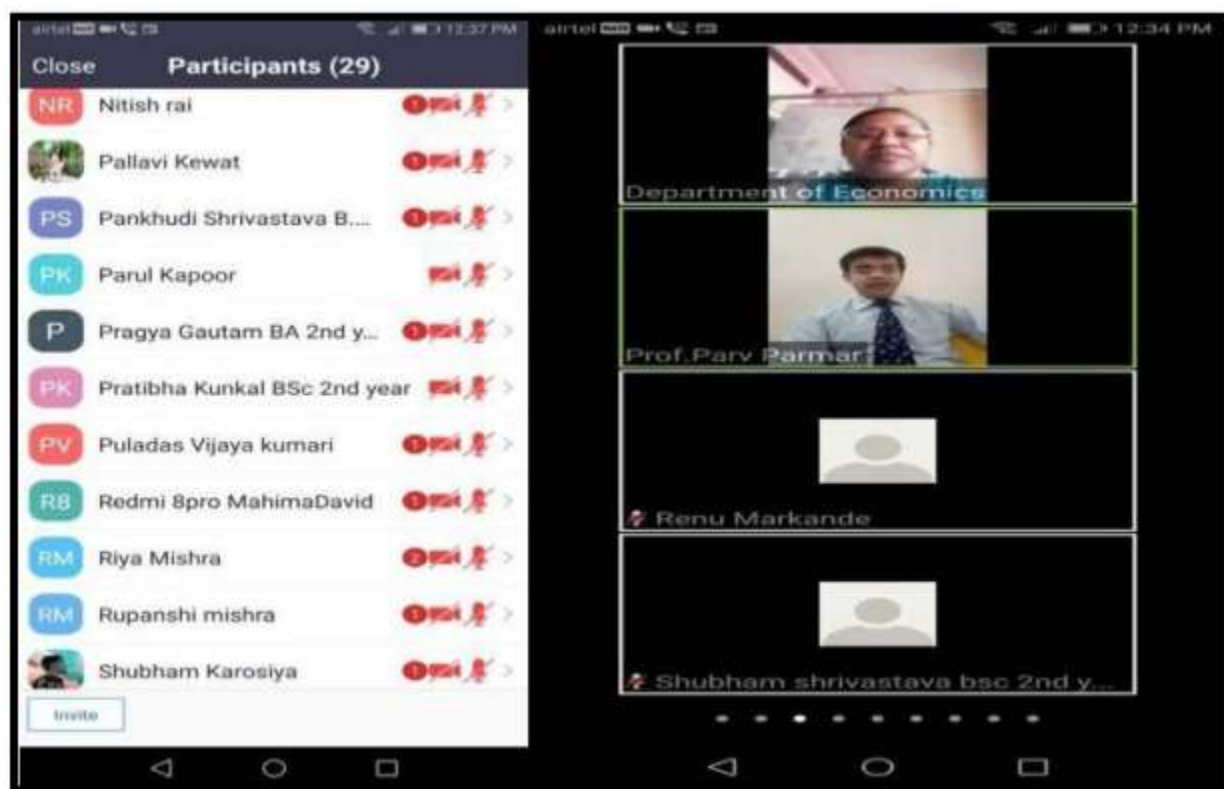
GUEST LECTURE
