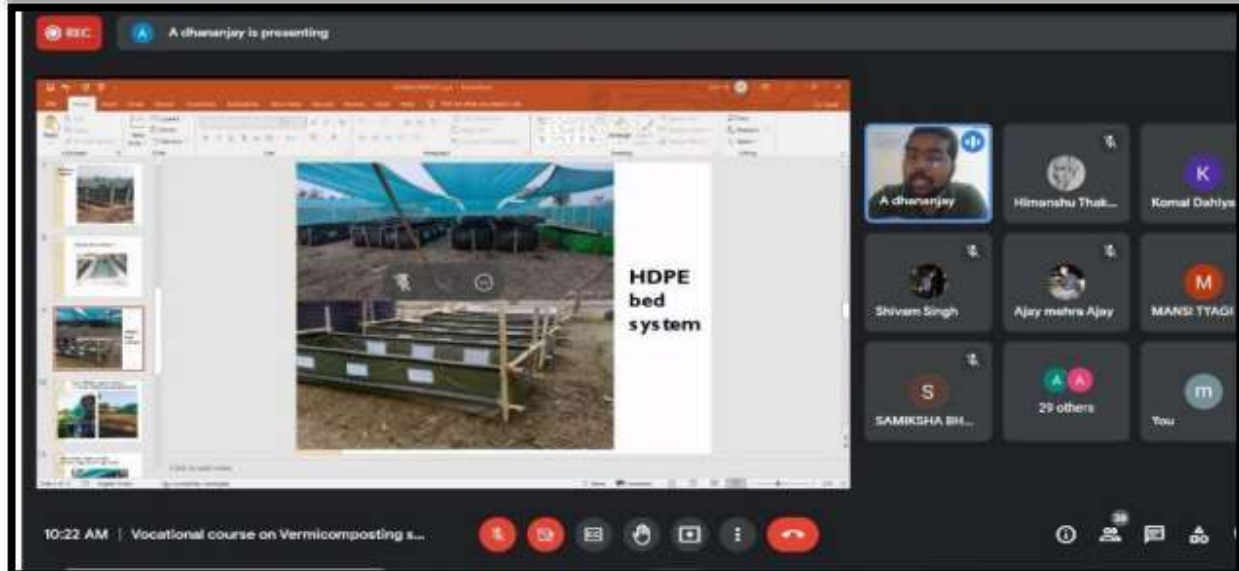
CAREER PROSPECTS IN COMPUTER SCIENCE AND APPLICATION

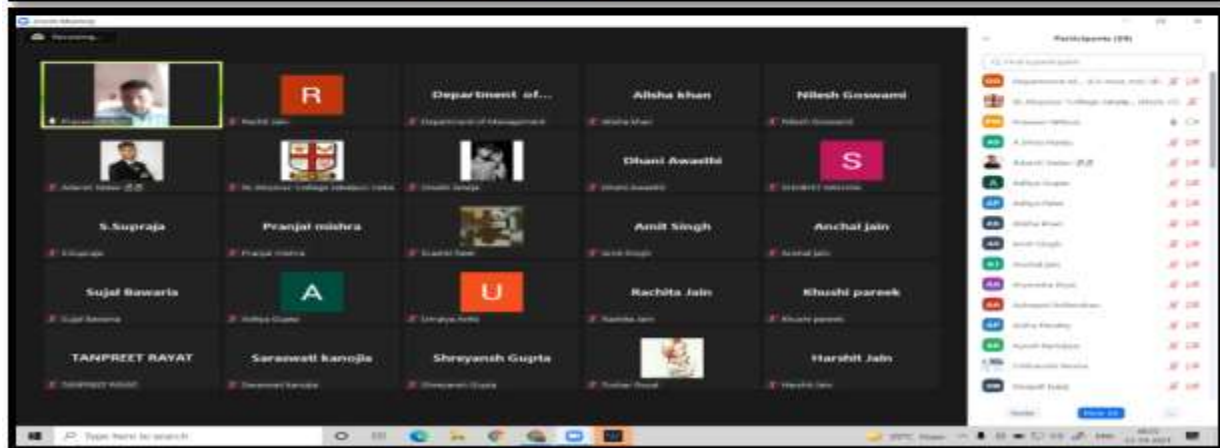
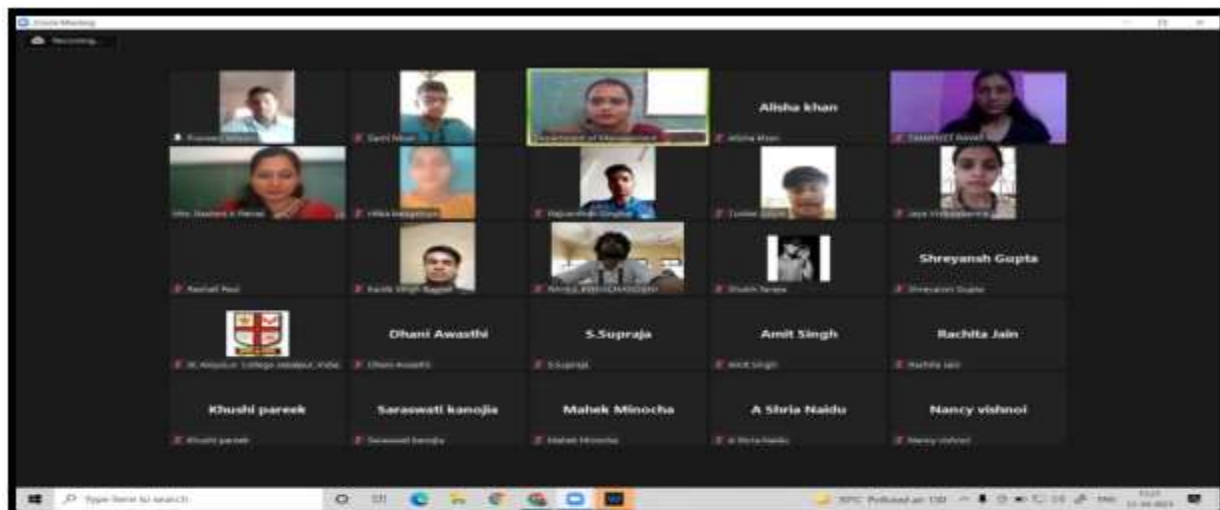
SEMINAR ON VERMICOMPOSTING DBT
