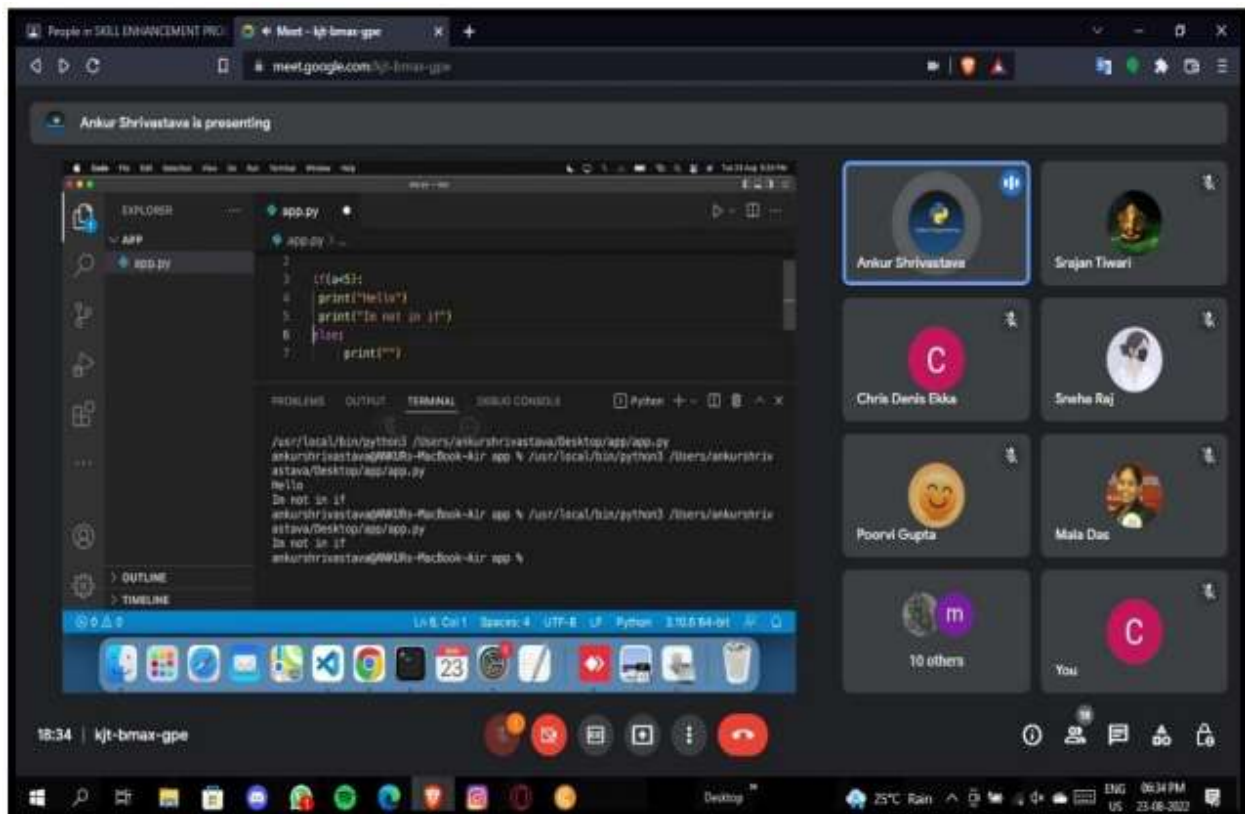
FELICITATION OF ACHIEVER & CELEBRATION OF FRIENDSHIP DAY

EXPERT TALK ON BIOINFORMATICS

Bioinformatics is an interdisciplinary field that develops methods and software tools for understanding biological data, in particular when the data sets are large and complex. Keeping in view the importance of these tools, the Department of Biotechnology organized a two day online expert talk on Bioinformatics on 27-28 February 2023 from 7:00pm-8:00pm. The distinguished speaker of the program was Ms. K.Srividya ,Project Research scholar, CSIR. CCMB, Hyderabad. She enlightens the importance and utility of bioinformatics in genomics and genetics, particularly those areas of genomics involving large-scale DNA sequencing. She also discussed the creation and advancement of databases, algorithms, computational and statistical techniques and practical problems in analysis of biological data. The speaker gave a detailed explanation about BLAST, NCBI, Primer designing and its usage. She concluded that the ultimate goal of Bioinformatics is to uncover the wealth of biological information hidden in the mass of sequence, structure, literature and obtain a clear insight of the fundamental biology of the organisms and use this information to enhance the standard of life for mankind. About 50 students participated in the talk.
