

The activities of club focused on initiatives to sensitize, create awareness, motivate and educate students about environment conservation. Different activities organized by the club during the session of 2023-24 are


#### **Disease Awareness**




**Students participating in Pictionary Competition**




**Slogan Competition on Importance of Millets** 











# **Poster making Competition**


#### **Poster competition on Millets**

## **Plantation program**






Plantation Program organized in the college campus










## Awareness programme on Sustainable Farming



## **Outreach Program on Pollution control day**


