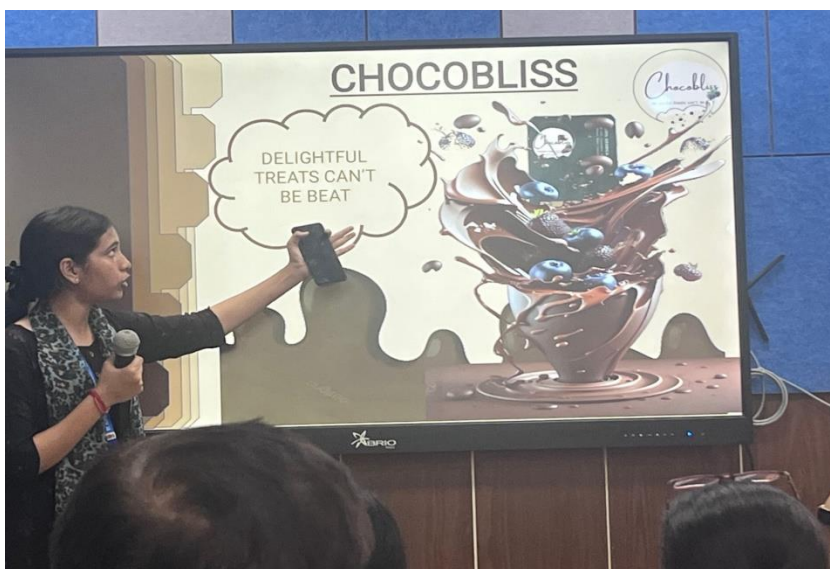


AD MAD SHOW

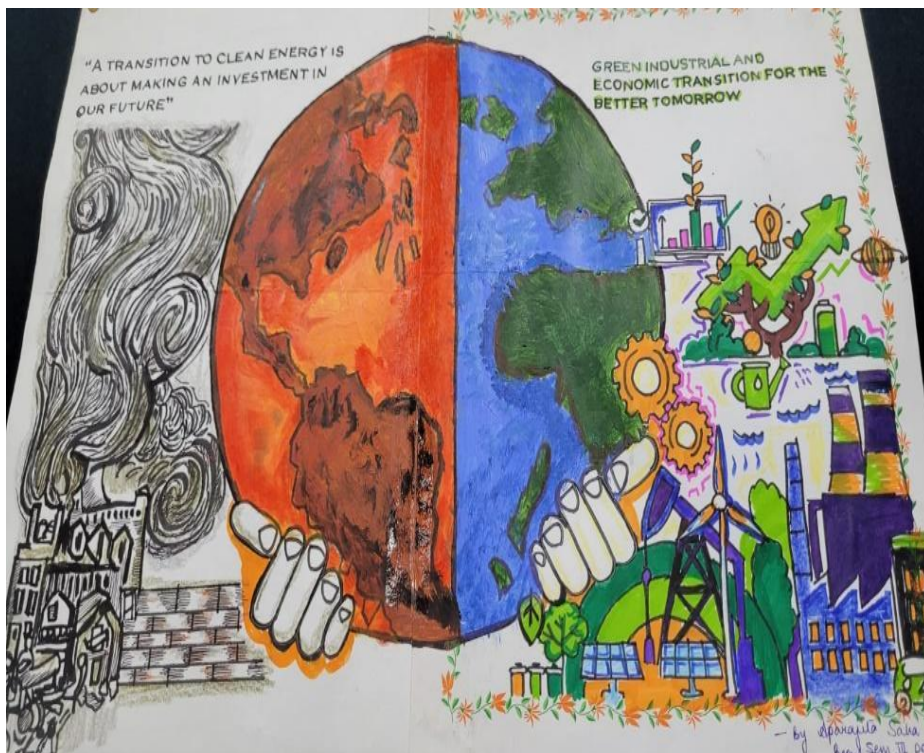


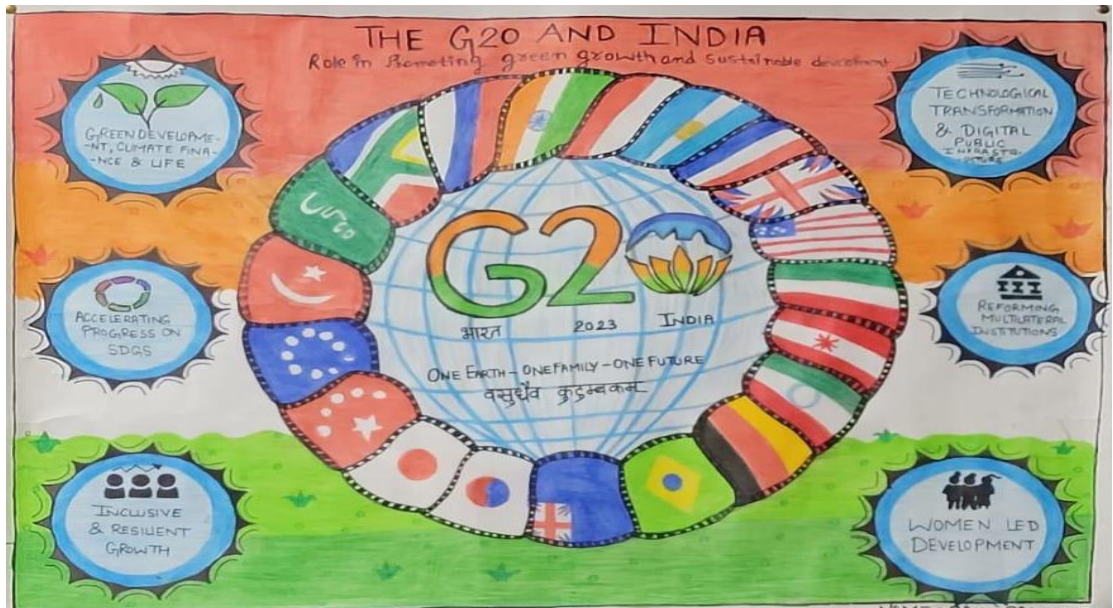
POSTER MAKING COMPETITION – G 20 AND GREEN GROWTH
