




Activities of Placement Cell

• 21st & 22nd July'22 – Two days UDAAN Session- From Campus to Corporate was organized by placement cell for final year students of the college by Dr. Chitranshi Verma, Asst. 




• On 14th Oct, Jaro education campus drive is held in our SAIT campus.









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On 10th Dec, the placement cell in collaboration with Department of Management organized a




