
Placement Statistics





Placement Activities

Report 2023-24

- Placement Cell Orientation Sessions were conducted for first year students from 26th July to 5th August'23 wherein they were briefed about activities of training and placement cell and how it can contribute in inculcating job ready skills in them. They were motivated to enroll for various certification courses for skill building and various internships as per their area of interests and their domains. As a result, 637 students were enrolled for Internshala, from where they can access several internships for them and college got rank 47 across India for the number of students enrolled and registered for various internships.
- Delhi based company Insplore Consultants selected 14 students for Internship in multiple profiles. It started from 14th July'23 wherein 14 students from B. Com were given certain assignments in domains of HR, Marketing and Finance.
- The leading Solutions Pvt. Ltd. Company offered summer internship to final year students.
- On 5th August'23, Mr. Amogh Gothoskar, trainer from Bombay Stock Exchange visited the campus and conducted two separate sessions for BBA and B.Com in which the students were made aware on various instruments of capital markets and functioning of stock markets. First session was attended by 122 students of BBA. In the second session, 168 students of B.Com were benefitted.












- On 23rd August 2023, a Career Counseling webinar on "Navigating a Rewarding Career in Pharmacy" was conducted for biotech and microbiology students. Resource person Mr. Ajay Rawat, Learn to Upgrade gave an overview of Pharmacy as a Career, Educational Pathways, Job Opportunities and Settings, Skills and Qualities of Successful Pharmacists, Career Advancement and Specialization to the participants. All the attendees got the DBT INDIA & NSDC associated Leanrntoupgrade certificate.
- On August 26, 2023, St. Aloysius College hosted an impactful orientation session named "Udaan" in collaboration with T.I.M.E. Jabalpur. The placement cell orchestrated the event which drew a substantial crowd of over 130 participants. Spanning 1.5 hours, the session boasted notable speakers, Mr. Abhishek Agrawal and Mr. Tapas Das. The discussion delved into vital aspects of the contemporary job landscape, encompassing the recruitment process and strategies for excelling in it. The discourse encompassed written test strategies, focusing on key domains like Logical Reasoning, Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension, and Quantitative Aptitude. Mr. Das illuminated the Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension (VARC) section, engaging students with interactive vocabulary and grammar exercises. Mr. Abhishek Agrawal expounded on Group Discussions, Personal Interviews, and LRDI (Logical Reasoning and Data Interpretation), while also outlining the benefits of the Udaan's comprehensive 3-month course. The event undoubtedly proved to be an enriching experience for all attendees.













• On 16th September 2023, Dr. Archana Rathore, IBS, Dean ICFAI, Jaipur was invited by placement cell to deliver insights about the soft skills requirements in the professional sphere and ways of enhancing the personality. She gave her valuable suggestions on changing job environment and role of soft skills, challenges faced during team work and role & qualities of a leader, Mind & Stimulus connection, and types of soft skills. 

was GD round followed by PI.






On 18th Nov, Mock Placement drive was conducted for students where they underwent a written

various streams of BA, BSc, B.Com and BBA participated in it.



and got benefitted through it.








DST-FIST Supported & Star College Scheme by DBT

• On 26th Feb'24, Teleperformance Campus drive was conducted for final year students.












On 11th March, Campus drive of Standard Moto Corp was organised wherein there were several
