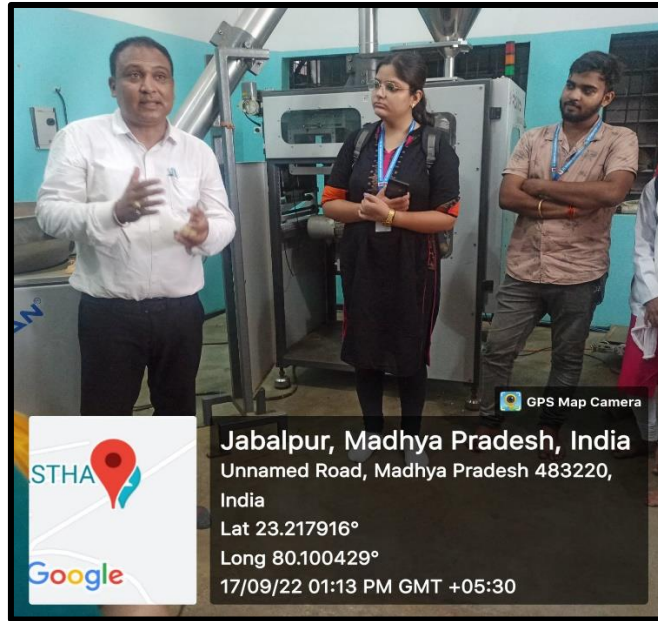
There main products include organic production and manufacturing of Stevia plant powder which is 100% natural, contains zero calorie and a natural sweetener, 30% sweeter than the sugar.
