Voter Awareness Drive Workshop - (24 September 2025):

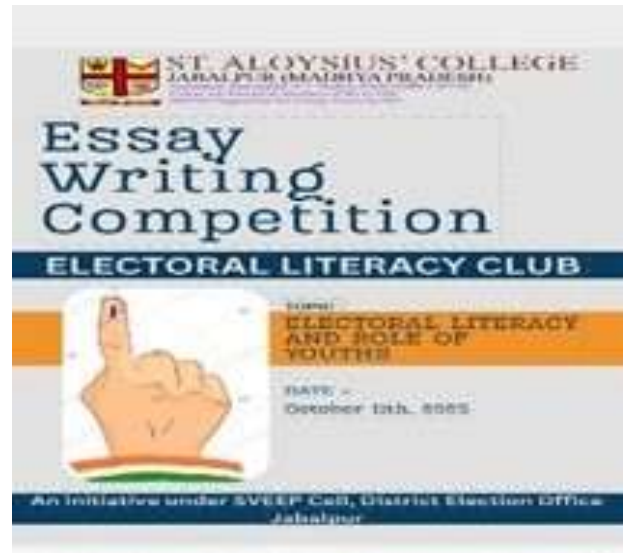

A workshop on Special Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls (SIR)-2026 was organised by SAC-ELC on 25th November 2025. The objective was to create awareness and provide practical training to students and staff regarding filling out the EF form.

The objective was successfully accomplished with 121 beneficiaries with the support of Master trainers Dr. Anupendra Singh, Lecturer, Polytechnic College, Jabalpur, and Mr. Dharendra Baghel, Assistant Professor, Jabalpur Engineering College, Jabalpur.



New Voter Registration Workshop - (8 - 9 January 2026):

A colossal campaign was undertaken by SAC-ELC to locate eligible students (above 18) who did not have a Voter ID card. SAC-ELC organised a two-day New Voter Registration Workshop on 8th and 9th January 2026. At the onset Nodal Officer presented the step-by-step registration process for New Voters. Parallely mentor teacher Ms. Yashica Choudhury and Campus Ambassador provided hands-on demonstration of the voter registration process through VHA. Dr. Shweta Likhitkar and Dr. Shivangi Dwivedi provided hands-on assistance in the practical session. District SVEEP Coordinator Dr. Pramod Srivastava participated in the program and provided valuable suggestions.

35 teachers attended the workshop. After comprehending the process of registration, each trained teacher registered new voters, collected and compiled the reference acknowledgements. Finally, Ms. Yashica Choudhury with the guidance of Dr. Mandira Kar prepared the compiled report for District SVEEP Cell, Jabalpur. A total of 114 new voter registration was done. This was the highest of all colleges in Jabalpur and for this drive Ms. Yashica Choudhury, Nodal Officer and Campus Ambassador were felicitated by SVEEP Cell, District Election Office, Jabalpur on the 16th National Voter’s Day 25th January 2026.



National Voters Day Celebration - (25 January 2026):
