DAY – 5

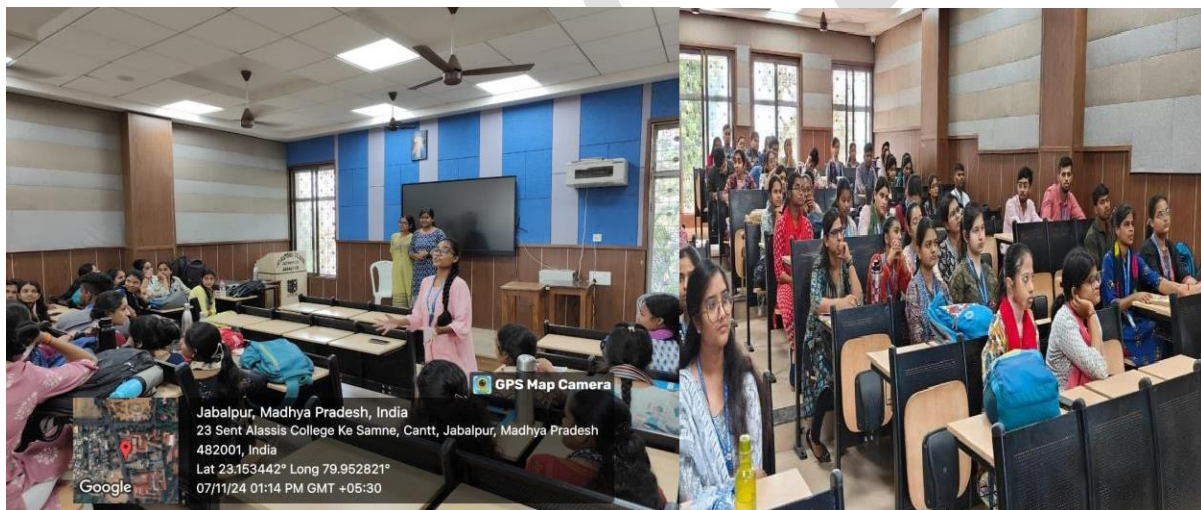
Topic - Stress Management

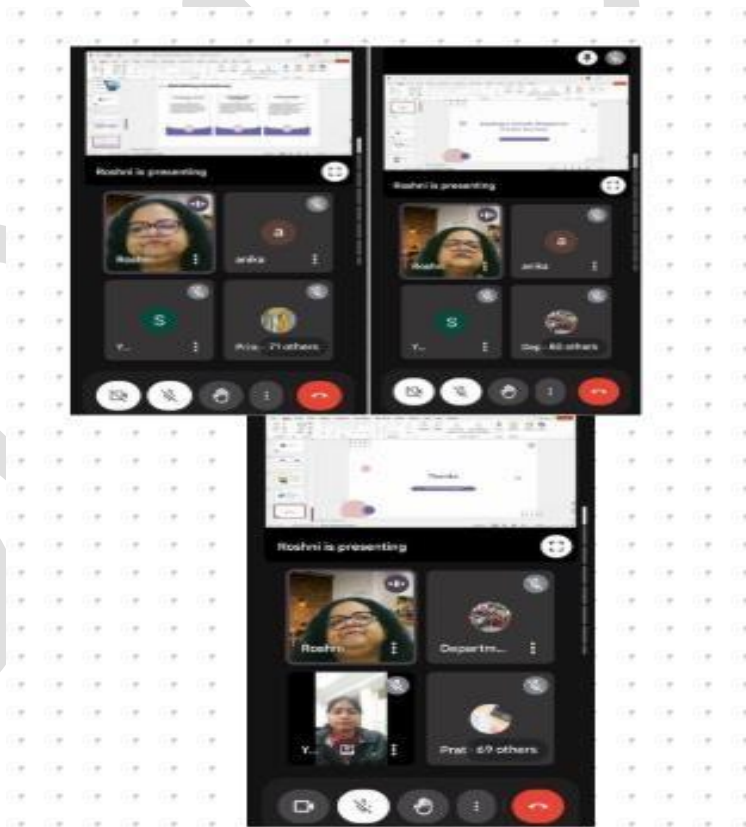
11. WEBINAR ON MINDSET FOR CAREER SUCCESS

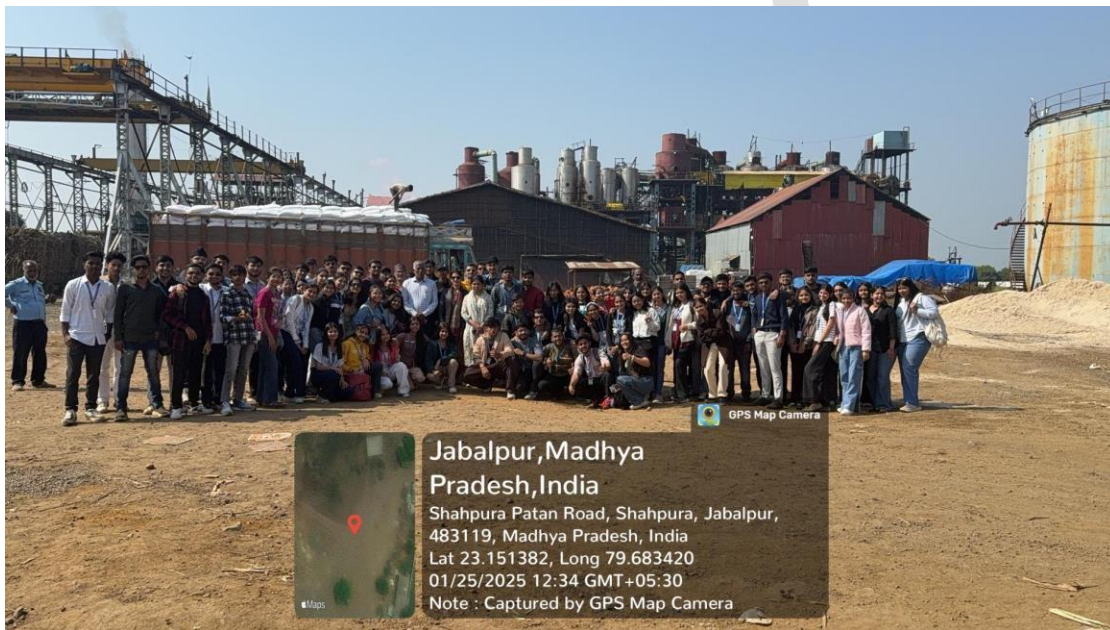




13.INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO SUGAR MILL

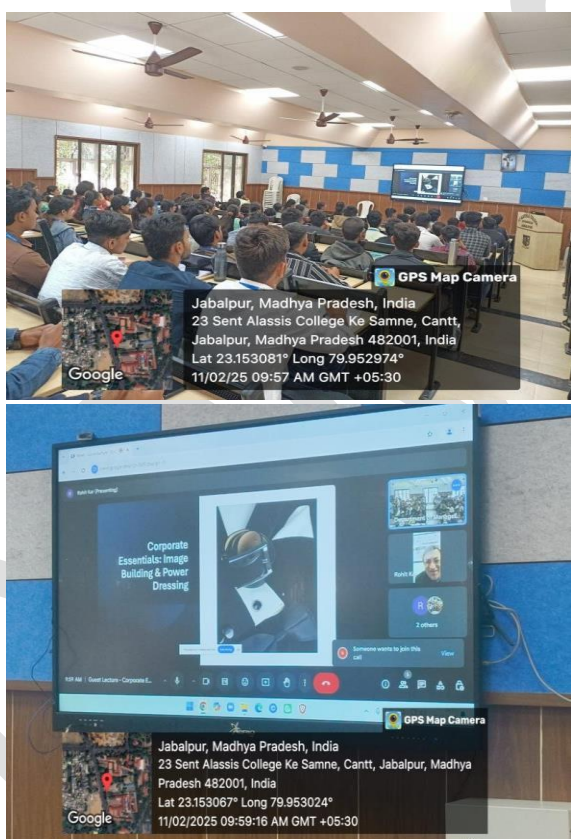


15. WEBINAR ON CORPORATE ESSENTIALS - IMAGE BUILDING AND POWER DRESSING
