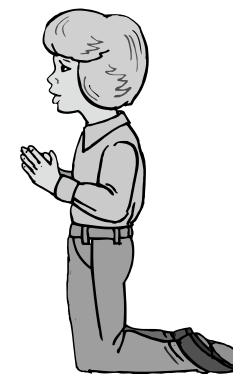

2. Attendance: Students are expected to attend College regularly. 75% attendance in every subject is a must. Defaulters may please note that they will not be allowed to appear in the main examination. If the Student is absent for 15 consecutive days without Prior information then his/her admission will be cancelled.

कक्षाएँ : महाविद्यालय में कक्षाओं को स्वच्छ रखना अनिवार्य है, डेस्क और दीवारों पर धूकना, लिखना, पोस्टर चिपकाना, यहाँ-वहाँ कागज फेंकना सख्त मना है। रिक्त कालखण्ड के दौरान छात्रों को निर्देशित किया जाता है कि वे कक्षाओं में ना बैठकर पुस्तकालय, वाचनालय या कॉमन रूम का प्रयोग करें। कक्षा प्रतिनिधियों से कक्षा के switchboards व स्वच्छता का ध्यान रखना अपेक्षित है।

6. Identity Cards : The Students Identity Card issued by the college is an important document to be carried by the students in the campus. It should be produced/surrendered on demand to any official of the institution. In the absence of the I-Card students shall not be issued library books, transfer certificates and caution money. The students will not be permitted to participate in any college function without the I - Card. If the I - Card is lost, the college authorities and the nearest police station have to be informed immediately. A Duplicate I - Card will be issued if a photocopy of the FIR is produced and on payment of Rs. 100/-.

7. Dress Code : Students are expected to be circumspect in their dress and demeanor. All of them should follow the dress code formal shirts & trousers for boys and Churidar/ Salwar Kamiz with dupatta for girls.

8. Postal Address : No letters are to be directed to the college address. Any change in the residential address must be brought to the notice of the college office in writing.

9. Grievance Redressal Cell : The Grievance Redressal Cell will look into matters regarding the functioning of the college, the academic and extra curricular activities. Any suggestion regarding the same may be put in the suggestion box or students may appeal to the cell.

Caution money is refundable within 3 years of leaving the college.

अवधान राशि कॉलेज छोड़ने के 3 वर्ष के भीतर ही दी जा सकेगी।

12. Punctuality : Students are expected to be punctual and make this habit a part of their character. They should be present in the college at 7:45 am (Morning Shift)/1:15pm (Afternoon Shift).

On joining the college a student becomes liable to abide by all the rules and regulation of the College. The decision of the Principal shall be final in all matters of discipline and enforcement of rules.

विद्यार्थियों से आशा की जाती है कि वे महाविद्यालय में समय का पालन जैसी आदत को अपने चरित्र का हिस्सा बनाये उन्हें महाविद्यालय में 7:45 प्रातः पाली / 1:15 दोपहर पाली में उपस्थित होना है।

प्रवेश लेने के बाद प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी के लिए महाविद्यालय के सभी नियमों का पालन करना अनिवार्य है। प्राचार्य का निर्णय अनुशासनात्मक कार्रवाई के लिए अंतिम रूप से मान्य होगा।

Code of Conduct (नियमावली)

- (a) Every student shall maintain the decorum of the College and be polite to the Principal, Vice-Principal, teachers, other staff and peers.
- (b) Every student shall totally concentrate on his/her studies and should actively participate in academic/non academic college functions.
- (c) Students are expected to maintain peace, harmony & cleanliness in the college. Admission shall be cancelled for

those who cause damage to college property including building, library, laboratories, hostel etc.

- (d) Students shall not indulge in any political activity in the college campus. Violence of any kind shall not be tolerated.
- (e) If students have any difficulty that needs to be addressed they can put it through their representative in a disciplined and peaceful manner to the teacher, if very necessary to the principal. They can also contact their mentor teacher or the grievance redressal cell. However they cannot by any means contact any outsiders.
- (f) Students shall not involve in any immoral / criminal activity. In case of any such involvement strict action shall be taken.
- (g) After admission if a student is found having submitted false documents / given false information / deliberately hidden important facts or if he/she has been admitted uncautiously then his/her admission can be terminated.
- (h) If a student leaves the college in mid session or is terminated mid session the student shall be refunded only the caution money. No other fees is refundable.
- (I) No student shall use his/her mobile phone in the class. If he/she is found doing so his/her phone shall be confiscated.

- (VI) अनैतिक व आपराधिक गतिविधियों में संलग्न पाए जाने पर छात्र के प्रति कठोर कार्यवाही की जाएगी।
- (VII) जाली प्रमाण पत्रों के आधार पर या गलत जानकारी देकर, जानबूझकर छिपाये गये प्रतिकूल तथ्यों या प्रशासनिक अथवा कार्यालयीन असावधानीवश किसी आवेदक को यदि प्रवेश मिल जाता है, तब संज्ञान में आने पर ऐसे प्रवेश को निरस्त करने का पूर्ण अधिकार प्राचार्य को होगा।

Library

The College has a rich library and a reading room for reference and study. It has a good collection of books, not only related to specific subjects but also journals and magazines to keep the students continuously updated about the world around them.

Guidelines for the students:

- The College library is fully automated.
- Students can access the library through their Identity Card.
- Before the examination it is compulsory for the students to get library clearance after submission of all CCE.

- Without library clearance the students, will not be able to get the admit card.
- Books from the College Library are issued to the students on days assigned for different classes.
- Two books are issued at a time for a period of 15 days. Books may be reissued for another 15 days provided they are not demanded by other students.
- Failure to return a book on expiry of due date will involve the payment of a fine of Rs. 1/- per day.
- All library books must be returned 15 days before the commencement of Final Examination.

Book Bank :

- Book Bank facility is available only for ST/SC and economically poor students.
- Students who avail the Book Bank facility must return the books immediately after the exams, failing which they will have to pay a fine of Rs. 1/- per day.

Reference Library :

- Reference books are not to be removed from the library. Students can use them in the library itself.

Digital Library

Campus NET™ Digital Library software is a fully web based application and users can avail from anywhere in the world. E-Resources can be accessed from the website www.staloyuscollege.in. All enrolled students are given a username and password to access the facility. Information from the college Digital Library server is available in different digital formats such as pdf, doc, power point files, excel files, html, chm files, images, videos and many more. All these documents can be accessed under different categories like e-Books, CD collections, College library books, best projects, assignments, study material, lecture notes etc.

EduSAC App

EduSAC is an app developed for the use of students, parents and teachers to access website, library & others facilities. Students are given sets of PINs & Passwords which they can use to login, and make use of the selective services activated at Edu SAC. This app can be downloaded from google play store.



Ragging is a criminal offence as per the Supreme Court Verdict. It is an offence under penal code and under section 116 of the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 (Karnataka Act No. 1, of 1995), which defines ragging as :

"Causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his/her person or exposes him/her to ridicule from doing any lawful act. By

intimidating wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining, or injuring him/her or by using criminal force on him/her or by holding out to him/her any threat of intimidating wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force."

"Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in this institution. The institute shall take strict action including criminal proceeding and cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging and the burden of proof shall hereby lie on the perpetrator of the alleged ragging and not on the victim. "An offence of Ragging may be charged either on a written complaint by the affected or on independent finding of the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2009."

Punishable elements constituents of Ragging

- Abetment/instigation to ragging.
- Criminal conspiracy to rag.
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging.
- Public nuisance created during ragging.
- Injury to body, causing hurt / mental trauma or grievous hurt.
- Physical Extortion or Psychological humiliation
- Any act / abuse by spoken words, e-mails, snail mails, blogs, public insults etc.
- Any act that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of a student

Punishments against Ragging :

- Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits
- Forfeiting from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process

- Withholding of results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of Admission.
- Rustication from the institution for a period, ranging from 1 to 3 years.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- Fine of Rs. 25000/-.
- Collective Punishment : When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

The fresher/junior students are hereby instructed that they should move in groups within the academic areas/campus, should not respond to the calls from seniors, should not participate in any kind of "fresher party" anywhere inside/outside the campus, desist from doing anything against their will even if ordered by the seniors. They are hereby assured that they have nothing to fear as the institution cares for them and shall not tolerate any atrocities against them.

परिसर में या अन्यत्र कहीं भी रैगिंग लेना पूरी तरह प्रतिबंधित है। रैगिंग के लिए दोषी विद्यार्थी को महाविद्यालय से निष्कासित किया जायेगा व उसके विरुद्ध कठोर निषेधात्मक कार्यवाही की जाएगी। वरिष्ठ विद्यार्थी इसका ध्यान रखें।

दण्ड - मध्य प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय अधिनियम 1973 के अधीन बनाये गये अध्यादेश क्र. 7 की धारा 13 के अनुसार महाविद्यालय परिसर या बाहर अनुशासन भंग किये जाने पर दोषी विद्यार्थी के विरुद्ध निम्नानुसार दण्ड का प्रावधान है -

1. कक्षाओं से निलम्बन।
2. महाविद्यालय से निष्कासन।
3. विवि/स्वाशासी परीक्षा में सम्मिलित होने से रोकना।

रैगिंग में संलिप्त विद्यार्थी के विरुद्ध कठोर दण्डात्मक कार्यवाही महाविद्यालय और छात्रावास से निष्कासन, छात्रवृत्ति तथा अन्य प्रदत्त लाभ वापस लेने की कार्यवाही के अलावा अर्थदण्ड और सार्वजनिक क्षमाचाना का भी प्रावधान रहेगा।

SCHEME FOR STUDENTS

1 Students Accident Insurance Scheme : The college has initiated the facility of Student Accident Insurance Scheme for students, with minimum premium. The maximum compensation paid by the insurance company in case of accident is given below :

Accidental Death with other benefits covered :

- (a) Death Only = 100% i.e. Rs. 1.00 Lac
- (b) Loss of Two Limbs, two Eyes = 100% i.e. Rs. 1.00 Lac
- (c) Loss of One limb or One Eye = 50% i.e. Rs. 50,000/-
- (d) Permanent Total Disablement from injuries other than those named above = 100% i.e. Rs. 1.00 Lac

Any accident must be reported within 24 hours to National Insurance Company for claim with following documents :

Document Needed for Accidental Death :

- (a) P.M. Report
- (b) FIR Report
- (c). Punchnama

Document Needed for Disablement Case:

1. FIR Report
2. Doctor's Certificate regarding % of Disablement.
3. Punchnama

Insurance will be applicable for 1st year students from 1st September onwards only.

2. Railway Concession : Student shall submit application for railway concession in the prescribed form 10 days in advance. The place mentioned in the column of permanent address of the admission form shall be taken as the students home town.

3 Teacher Guardian Scheme : For the all round development and better academic growth of students the college has the teacher guardian scheme. From time to time teacher guardian meetings are held through which information of activities of the college is given.

4. Bishop Cecil Desa Scholarship : Merit scholarship for Toppers in all streams of academics.

6. Hari Vishnu Kamath Vidyadan Vishvasta Nidhi Scholarship: Award of Rs. 10,000/- for students who stand first in the field of Science, Economics & Political Science.

4. डॉ. श्यामाप्रसाद मुखर्जी योजना : मध्यप्रदेश शासन द्वारा चलाई जा रही छात्रवृत्ति डॉ. श्यामाप्रसाद मुखर्जी योजना के अंतर्गत कक्षा 12 वीं में जो विद्यार्थी मेरिट अंक प्राप्त करते हैं, तथा गरीबी रेखा के नीचे जीवन यापन कर रहे हैं किन्तु जिनकी वार्षिक आय 3,00,000/- से कम हो एवं महाविद्यालय में नियमित रूप से प्रवेश लेने पर उक्त योजना से छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जा सकती है।

5. पोस्ट मैट्रिक छात्रवृत्ति : आदिवासी, हरिजन एवं पिछड़ा वर्ग के छात्र छात्राएँ जो मध्यप्रदेश राज्य के बाहर निवास करते हैं छात्रवृत्ति हेतु अपने राज्य से अपने पिता/पालक का वित्तीय वर्ष की आय, जाति एवं निवास प्रमाण पत्र साथ में लावें। छात्रवृत्ति आवेदन भर उसे अनिवार्य रूप से संलग्न करें। साथ में स्थानांतरण प्रमाण पत्र की छायाप्रति (प्रमाणित) अनिवार्य रूप से लगावें, इसके अभाव में आवेदन पत्र स्वीकार नहीं किया जायेगा।

10. मुख्यमंत्री जनकल्याण (शिक्षा प्रोत्साहन) योजना: महाविद्यालय के उन विद्यार्थियों को सूचित किया जाता है, जिनके माता/पिता का म.प्र. शासन के श्रम विभाग में असंगठित कर्मकार के रूप में पंजीयन हो, ऐसे विद्यार्थियों को स्नातक पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश प्राप्त करने पर मुख्यमंत्री जनकल्याण (शिक्षा प्रोत्साहन) योजना के अंतर्गत शिक्षण शुल्क राज्य शासन द्वारा वहन किया जायेगा। योजना के अंतर्गत स्नातक पाठ्यक्रम हेतु व्यय शुल्क के रूप में प्रवेश शुल्क एवं वह वास्तविक शुल्क (मेस शुल्क एवं कॉशन मनी को छोड़कर) जो शुल्क विनियामक समिति अथवा म.प्र. निजी विश्वविद्यालय विनियामक आयोग अथवा भारत सरकार/ राज्य शासन द्वारा निर्धारित किया गया है, का ही भुगतान किया जायेगा।

नोट : विद्यार्थी केवल एक ही छात्रवृत्ति की पात्रता रखते हैं। एक से अधिक छात्रवृत्ति हेतु फार्म भरने पर विद्यार्थी की सभी छात्रवृत्ति की पात्रता रद्द कर दी जाएगी।

EXAMINATION

Annual System of Examination

1. The three year degree courses (e.g. B.A., B.B.A., B.C.A., B.Sc., B.Com., B.Com.(Honours) to be run under Annual Pattern of examination, except those for which the University has separate ordinances, (e.g. M.A., M.Sc., M.Com.) shall be run under semester/ CBCS system.
2. The Annual system shall also be applicable to private students. The duration of these courses of study shall extend over three academic years.
3. Every candidate seeking admission to these courses shall be required to have passed 10+2 examination (Higher Secondary) of M.P. Board/ C.B.S.E. any other equivalent body recognized by the university for this purpose.

Provided that, for the purpose of admission in Honours courses the min marks required shall be 60% as notified by the university/state Government from time to time.
4. The under graduate courses in Annual system shall consist of:-
 - a. Such Subjects/ Papers, job internship, Lab works, Practical. etc. as may be prescribed by the University/State Government from time to time.
 - b. Such Syllabus and the scheme of examination as may be presented by the state Government or University as the case may be, from time to time.
5. Each student shall have to appear separately in the examination of Theory/ Practical and Continuous Comprehensive examination (CCE)/Internal Assessment (IA). if he/she is eligible and has not otherwise been

prevented by the university/ college from appearing in the examination. The CCE/ IA will be held in the manner prescribed from time to by the University / State Govt.

6. For passing the examination, the candidate shall be required to secure minimum marks (As prescribed in the relevant scheme) in the year end examination separately in Theory, Practical (if any) and CCE.
7. There shall be supplementary examination for the eligible candidates. Theory, Practical and CCE/ IA shall be treated as separate subjects for this purpose.
 - (i) If a candidate fails in one subject and clears all the remaining subject of that examination, he/she will be allowed to appear in the supplementary examination for two consecutive chances only.

Provided that, if a candidate fails in more than one subject in any examination he/she shall be declared FAIL, and allowed to appear in the next examination as ex-student of the same class.

Provided also, that if a candidate is unable to clear the supplementary examination in the chances prescribed in sub para

- (i) he/she shall be declared fail and shall have to appear in all the papers of the said examination again.
 - (ii) The candidate shall be awarded degree only in the year when he/she clears all the papers.
 - (iii) In all the above cases the candidates shall be required to appear in the examination as per prevailing syllabus and scheme applicable at the time of examination.
 - (iv) Any changes notified any time by the state Govt. in the criteria of eligibility of supplementary examination, shall overrule the above provisions.
8. No candidate shall be allowed to appear in the examination unless he/she has:

- i. Attended at least 75% of lectures/practicals delivered separately (For Regular candidates only)
 - ii Paid all the fees due:
 - iii Obtained "NO DUES" certificate from the concerned Department/college.
 - iv. Submitted the job internship certificate/ Project report, as notified by Head/ Principal.
9. The Division (In the final result shall be awarded on the basis of grand total of marks obtained in the Theory, Practical and CCE/IA of all the examination of the course concerned.

60% or above	First Division
45% or above but less than 60%	Second Division
Min Passing Marks or above but less than 45%	Third Division

IN P.G. COURSES

60% or above	First Division
48% or above but less than 59.99 %	Second Division
34 % to 47.99 %	Third Division

10. If an examinee is failing or missing a division, he/she shall be entitled for Grace marks as per the following provisions.
- (i) **Kulpati Grace (KG)** may condone the deficiency of ONE mark only in case the examinee is failing or missing a division by ONE mark where the deficiency is so condoned.
 - (ii) **General grace (G)** of maximum Three marks shall be given in to the examinee to pass the examination if he/she fails in not more than two subjects by not more than three marks. But secures the minimum aggregate marks required.

Provided that the benefit of the provisions of sub para (i) and (ii) above will not be given to an examinee simultaneously.

Revaluation, Scrutiny & View of the answer book..

Rules for Revaluation

- (a) A candidate whose result of main examination has been declared, may apply to the Principal for the revaluation of his answer books (only theory examination), in the form (prescribed by the (college) within 15 days from the date of declaration of results with the fee prescribed.
- (b) Provided that no candidate shall be allowed to have more than two answer books revalued. Provided also that no revaluation shall be allowed in case of practical, field work, seminar, sessional work, CCE/IA test and thesis/ dissertation/ project report submitted at the examination and also for the supplementary examination. Provided also that when the result of the candidate is withheld for non-compliance of certain conditions on his part (e.g. non submission of Migration Certificate or Original documents , case of unfair means etc.) the time limit of for accepting his form would not be extended on this account, i.e. it would be within 15 days after the date of declaration of the main result.
- (c) The fee for revaluation shall be Rs 500/- per answer books which is not refundable. Provided that if the revaluation has not been done due to unavoidable circumstances, full amount (Except processing charges) of fees paid for revaluation will be refunded for each answer books.
- (d) The Scrutiny /Retotaling of marks shall be done before the answer-books are sent for revaluation without the candidate applying for it and if any change is found necessary action to revise the marks will be taken accordingly and revaluation will be undertaken if the candidate still desires to get his answer -books revalued.
- (e) The result of revaluation shall be communicated to the

candidate. even if there is no change in the marks through college website.

Scrutiny (Retotaling of answer books)

- (a) Any candidate, who has appeared at any year end examination of the college, may apply to the Principal for the scrutiny of his marks on the written paper in any subject and rechecking of his results.
- (b) Such application must be made in the form prescribed by the college so as to reach the Principal within 15 days from the date of the declaration of the result. Provided that when the result of the candidate is withheld for non compliance of certain conditions on his part (e.g. non-submission of Migration certificate of Original documents, case of unfair means etc). The time limit for accepting his form would not be extended i.e. it would be within 15 days from the date of declaration of result.
- (c) Such application must be accompanied with a fee of Rs. 200/- for each answer books to be scrutinized, This fee shall be Non-Refundable.

Provided that of Scrutiny (Retotaling has not been done due to unavoidable circumstances, the full amount (Except processing charges) for Scrutiny/Retotaling will be refunded for each answer books.

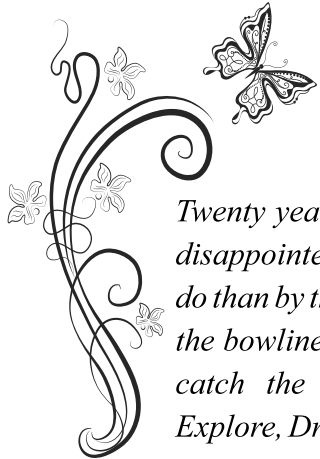
