

Intercollegiate Training on Vermicomposting



The Department of Zoology conducted three months internship training programme on Vermicomposting for Solid Wastes as Sustainable Practice form 20thJanuary to 26th March 2018 for the students of various colleges of Jabalpur in order to promote entrepreneurship skills and leadership qualities among them. 78 students were the beneficiaries of this training programme.

GST Training: The Dept. of Commerce organized a five days Crash Course from January $29^{th} - 2^{nd}$ February on GST, sponsored by CGST Department, Jabalpur. More than 200 students of B.Com. VI semester participated and understood the implication of the Goods and Sales Tax.

National Workshops

The Department of Mathematics organized two days National Training Programme on **"The Art of Mathematical Modeling as Teaching Pedagogy"**, on 9th and 10th February 2018 sponsored by UNITED BOARD for Christian Higher Education in Asia Region. More than 250 participants attended this workshop and were introduced to various modeling techniques which makes teaching and learning more interesting and easy.



The College conducted two days National Workshop on "e-Learning, MOOCS and Basic ICT Tools for Educators" on 17th and 18th March 2018. The Chief Guest was Prof. A.K. Bakshi, Vice-Chancellor, PDM University and Chairman, GAD-TLC of MHRD, the Guest of Honour was Dr. Vimal Rarh, Joint Director GAD – TLC and the Special Guest was Prof. K.V. Bhanumurthy, Vice Chairman, GAD-TLC of MHRD. The participants were taught to make teaching modules under Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCS).The workshop consisted of interactive sessions to design courses to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity and quality.

Forum Activity

Technozion: The Department of Computer Science organized "Technozion 2018" from $2^{nd} - 6^{th}$ February 2018 under the banner of the "Computer Forum". 100 students participated in different activities like quiz, poster making, animation, debugging and model competition.

Yuva Sansad: The Department of Political Science organized 'Youth Parliament' on 4thApril 2018 in collaboration with Pt. Kunjilal Dubey Rashtriya Sansadiya Vidyapeeth, Bhopal to develop leadership skills and create political awareness about parliamentary democracy among students.

Memorandum of Understanding

In order to provide international exposure to students and offer a platform for understanding global perspective, the college signed two MOU's with renowned international universities:

East Carolina University: A MOU was signed with East Carolina University for conducting certificate courses in Commerce, Political Science, Chemistry, Bio-Science-Botany, Zoology and Bio-Technology. It also includes students and teachers exchange programs.

Assumption University: A MOU was also signed with Assumption University, Bangkok. It will help students to pursue M.B.A. programme, to undertake one week programme which includes industrial visits, special classroom lecture from eminent faculties and cultural get together. It will also enable M.Sc. Biotechnology final semester students to take up projects.

Research Awards

Under its Best Practices the college has instituted an award in three categories namely the Best Paper Award and Best Community Oriented Project in the teachers category and the Best Research Project Award in the student category. The awards were given on 26th January 2018. The recipients were Dr. Archana Singhal, Dr. Daya Shankar Gautam and Ms. Shivangi Gupta of B. Ed. II Semester respectively.

Orientation Programme

For teachers:

A week long orientation program was conducted for the teachers by the IQAC under which the new manual for AQAR and SSR was discussed. The Qualitative and Quantitative metrics for criterion I, II and III were discussed.

A special session on "Relationships" was taken up by Fr. Amritraj of Nagpur Seminary. He spoke on the ten foundational virtues required for being interconnected, interrelated, interdependent, inter supportive. **For students:**
