Prajwal Gupta of B.Com. II Year won Gold medal at the All India OGKFI of Karate Competition



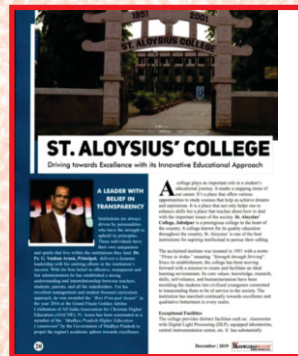
राष्ट्रीय स्पर्धा में जयराम चौधरी अखिल
