### The Process

The softcopy report of the Academic and Administrative Audit was submitted to the team. Then video conferencing meet was organized with the members of the team, Principal, IQAC coordinator and the heads of various departments. The Head's of the departments gave a brief input on the various activities undertaken by their department. The team had a thorough discussion with the Principal, IQAC Coordinator and faculty members. Dr. Siby Samuel, Coordinator IQAC, coordinated the Audit process.

St. Aloysius' College was ranked the top college in Madhya Pradesh and one of the ten most admired in India. It received the Star College Scheme from the Department of Biotechnology and saw students excel in NCC, sports, and various academic conferences, highlighting the college's commitment to holistic development and national recognition.

## **The Observations**

Based on the data provided by the college and extensive virtual discussions with the faculty and authorities of the college, the team has identified the strengths and concerns of the college as given below:

- a. Updation of syllabi:** The departments has taken initiatives to update the syllabus of various subjects being taught by incorporating the topic related to Entrepreneurship, Employability and Skill development in the curriculum. This has been materialized by cooperating various skill based topics practical and projects, organizing add-on courses, emphasizing on communication skills, computational skills, Personality Development, Entrepreneurship Skill, Personal Personnel Productivity skills, thereby inculcating hard and soft core skills.

**b. Innovative processes in Teaching and Learning:**

The quality of education is critical to an institution's success; therefore, the college has taken pioneer step to interrogate a number of strategies and methods with the purpose to improve learning process and strengthen governance along with the traditional learning methods. The initiatives undertaken to enhance teaching and learning were online and digital enhancements to the curricula, evidence-based pedagogy and community building. It also involved a different way of looking at problems and solving them and a thinking process that will help the students to develop their creativity and their problem-solving skills.

- c. Internal Evaluation System:** Assessment of performance is an integral part of teaching and learning process. As a part of sound educational strategy, the institution adopts Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) System to assess all aspects of a student's development on a continuous basis throughout the year.

The modes under taken were

- Unit test were taken after the completion of every unit.
- I Year: Essay type questions were given so that students enhance their capacity to write long answers.
- II Year: Multiple Choice questions/Short /Long Answer type
- III Year: Different modes (Micro-teaching, role play, projects, survey etc) adopted in final year class at the UG level and in all PG classes.
- Half yearly examination conducted according to the format of the main examination

**d. Student Support**

Apart from the curriculum, the students are provided with academic skills to improve their language skills, writing skills, problem solving skills, presentation skills etc. Also, the college is supporting the financially weak students and in this current year 186 students received college level scholarship and 1119 students are the recipient of state government scholarship.

**e. In-house Faculty Training programme**

The faculty members are engaged in in-house trainings in order to build a cohesive working, customize the teaching and learning based on the needs of the organization and also to standardize the operations. The college organized 05 Faculty Development Programme and time to time the Data Centre is providing training on the usage of the Management /automation software.

**f. Campus eco-friendly**

Green and ecological campus is the adage of the college where environmentally friendly practices and education are accomplished to promote sustainable eco-friendly environment. It also offers an opportunity to take the lead in redefining its environmental culture and developing new paradigms by creating sustainable solutions to environmental, social and economic needs of the mankind. The following are the initiative drives undertaken by the college like, regular plantation campaign, polythene-free campus, road show for waste management and zero pollution awareness among students and general public, students are educated regularly regarding proper disposal of lab waste, certain reagents have been replaced with eco-friendly and green compounds, the concept of green chemistry like hazardous chemicals are not drained in the sink but collected, treated and reused, to reduce large use of chemicals, microanalysis is promoted. The enhanced use of E-Governance has reduced the wastage of paper and stationary.

**g. Gender sensitization programmes**

The college is very pro towards gender sensitization and equality for which many activities were held like activities like Stri Suraksha Samvad (Women Safety Discourse), Health checkup, Sanitary napkin awareness program etc.

**h. Students mentoring system**

The mentoring system adopted by the college is a Continuous, Accomplishment, Reflection and Experience (CARE) Programme. The continuous interpersonal relationship between the mentor teacher and the mentee student is an experience of caring, sharing and

growing. The mentee students feel understood and appreciated and gain in self-esteem and self-confidence. The teacher student (mentor: mentee) ratio is 1:46

### About the College

St. Aloysius“ College is a land of prospects, willpower, dedication and unswerving commitment to be the finest. Ever since its inception in 1951, the institute stands firm in its indomitable responsibility to shape dependable and meticulously responsible citizens of the country. With the imposing aspiration to prepare morally literate and professionally educated individuals to become the responsible citizens of the nation by serving humanity; the institute tries to excel in all-round development of students.

One of the most significant achievements of the academic year 2019-20 was that the college is recognised as one of the leading colleges by two leading magazines of the country. *Careers' 360* in association with ICFAI (Special Issue on India's Best Universities 2020), March 2020: Vol. XII, Issue 3, published the top-rated colleges, listed state-wise where most students first go. St. Aloysius“ College is listed and ranked as number one college in the state of Madhya Pradesh where most students first go. *The Knowledge Review*, another notable magazine of the country in their special issue on '10 Most Admired Private Universities in India, 2019', ranked the college as one of the ten most admired colleges of the country.

The institution has another feather in its cap with being Star College Scheme granted by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi.

The college provides ample opportunities to the youngsters for grooming themselves by joining NCC, NSS, clubs and societies. With its magnificent record in NCC, this year too, 4 cadets were selected to represent India as the Indian Youth Ambassador namely: Cadet Rohit Pandey visited Russia, Senior Cadet Captain Anjali Ann Joseph visited Kazakhstan, Cadet Sachet Sharan Sund visited Sri Lanka, and Senior under Officer Aditi Verma visited Singapore. Senior under Officer Aditi Verma received the Chief Minister Commendation for the Best Cadet 2019-20 of the Directorate. This year eight cadets represented the MP & CG Directorate in 2020. Six Cadets were selected for NSC 2019 at Vishakhapatnam.

Social Service is the definition of NSS and the NSS wing of the institution thrives to cater to the needs of humanity and promote in others, the same emotion.

The NSS unit (boys& girls) organized a camp at villages. The girls unit organised corona awareness rally, conducted independent thinking on social issues like importance of wearing



masks, distribution of masks, putting *sakor*s for birds, using posters for creating consciousness in society to stay at home safely during the pandemic.

The *Aloysians* have left an imprint in the field of sports this year as well. Muskan Kirar represented India at Asian Games 2019 and won silver medal at the games. Divyansh Manoj won a Silver medal in Wushu in an International event. Prajjwal Gupta won a gold medal in Karate, Jayaraj Choudhary won Gold in Flying Kick; Gold and Silver in Taekwondo, Yashika Sharma and Anita Devi won bronze medals in Strength Lifting and cycling respectively. In the intercollegiate events the college was winner in Volleyball (Men & Women), Chess (Men & Women), Table Tennis (Men & Women), Badminton (Men), Basketball (Women).

In order to improve the skills as learning-centered teachers and to identify the challenges and transformative learning objectives the college make provisions to organize seminars, training programs etc. IQAC organized two days NAAC sponsored, National Seminar on “Accreditation, Ranking and Quality: A Paradigm shift for strategic Enhancement of Higher Education in India” on 8-9 November 2019. In the seminar, twenty-one research papers were presented and one hundred ten candidates participated.

The Department of Hindi organized a two day National Seminar on “*Rashtrabhasha, Rajbhasha Aur Ab Vishvabhasha Hindi –Vishva Vyapaar Ewam Varnijya ke Vishesh Sandharbh Mei*”, sponsored by ICSSR New Delhi on February 3-4, 2020. In the two day seminar one hundred and fifty research papers were presented and three hundred and fifty candidates participated and were benefitted.

The institution encourages and provides for all round development of teachers and students alike. During lockdown, many webinars, FDPs and national - international conferences were organised by different departments. An Internal Quality Assurance Cell of college organized two day online National conference on “Quality in Teaching, Learning, and Evaluation: A Need for Academic Excellence” on 29-30 May 2020. The online conference benefitted a total of one thousand four hundred and seventy eight participants from all pockets of the nation.

The Faculty of Life Sciences organized a two day online National Conference on “Life Sciences Challenges and Opportunities: COVID – 19 PANDEMIC” on 1-2 June 2020. Twelve research papers were presented and there were eight hundred and thirty three participants.

The Department of Education organized a two day online National Conference on “Role of E-Resources and Mind Mastering Strategies in Education” on 9-10 June 2020. Eleven selected research papers were presented and three hundred and seventy seven candidates participated.

The Faculty of Physical Sciences organized two day online International conference on

“Advances in Physical, Mathematical and Computational Science” on 12-13 June 2020. Twenty-two quality research papers have been invited to be presented and eight hundred and thirty six candidates participated.

The Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences organized a two day online National Conference on “Migrant Labour: A Political–Economic-Social-Cultural Perspective” on 26-27 June 2020. Ten selected research papers were invited to be presented and seven hundred and forty five members participated.

These programs enable the faculty develop educative assessment strategies that allow them to measure success, continue to innovate, and create even deeper learning.

We stand together until the end.” The college celebrates unity and brotherhood through JIRF, a body that brings different religions together. This year the college celebrated Deepawali on 5 November 2019 to mark the festival of lights, joy and happiness. The 550<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Shri Guru Nanak Devji, was celebrated on 26 November 2019 to communicate the spiritual messages of Shri Guru Nanak Dev amongst the followers of different faiths. Christmas was celebrated on 20 December 2019 to spread the message of love, joy and peace.

St. Aloysius“ College provides research environment to both teachers and students to grow and upgrade their profiles in keeping with the paradigm shifts worldwide. The teachers attended international and national conferences and seminars organized in India and outside, published 4 edited books, chapters in books, research papers presented at National and International seminars and conferences, published research papers reputed journals, also sanctioned one major and three minor research projects by ICSSR.

Like every year, the Placement Cell hosted various training programmes and sessions to enhance employability skills of students; twelve companies visited the campus and forty seven students of various UG & PG programmes were offered placements. Through various training sessions and workshops being conducted in the year, around one thousand and six hundred students of the college were benefitted.

The upgradation of the downtrodden and the marginalized is the only way to develop a harmonious nation. The institute leaves no stone unturned to make the students empathize to work for the feeble, old and orphans in society in order make them realize their errands towards them. The Women Cell, Rotary Club and Red Ribbon Clubs render their valuable services towards this cause. This is achieved through bringing awareness in them by paying visits to orphanages, old age homes, mental retarded centers, blood donation camp etc. These

are part of training of students to fulfill the objectives of the institution.

The college promotes students to enhance their personalities by participating in various co-curricular activities. Various cultural fests are organized by different departments namely, Kala Utsav, Technozion, SRIJAN, AAGAZ, AMA Fest were organized so that the students may discover their unknown talents and sharpen their skills as talented performers.

St. Aloysius' College has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with CMA, Bajaj Finserv, Sophia Girls' College, Ajmer and Patna Women's College, Patna. With Bajaj Finserv, the College conducted a Certificate Course on CPBFI. Seventy-four students benefitted from this certificate course. The College is also running a course in B.Com with US Career in Management and Accounting (CMA), provided by WILEY, that offers the course all through the country. In collaboration with Patna Women's College, Patna and Sophia Girls' College, Ajmer, two national workshops were organized.

The college organized a Student Exchange Programme in collaboration with Sophia Girls' College, Ajmer; eight students along with one faculty member attended an International Staff and Student Exchange Programme from 27 January 2020 to 2 February 2020.

The institution believes that there is a need to develop a suitable curriculum and consistently update it to maintain the quality of education and enhance employability. ## 20. What is the method for conducting internal evaluation?

Two internal assessments were conducted- quarterly and half yearly examinations. For the students of the 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year, the quarterly examination was conducted at the departmental level and different modes were used at the discretion of the subject teachers. The half yearly examination was conducted centralized by the Examination cell and long type questions were asked to give them the practice.

Apart from this the subject teachers assess the students with class test or surprise test or any mode of assessment after the completion of every unit.
