Save Water Rally

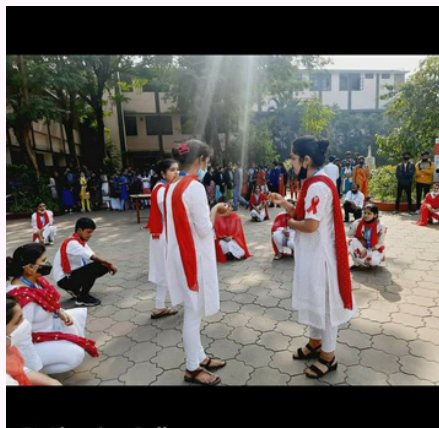

Name of the product: OB Cubes.

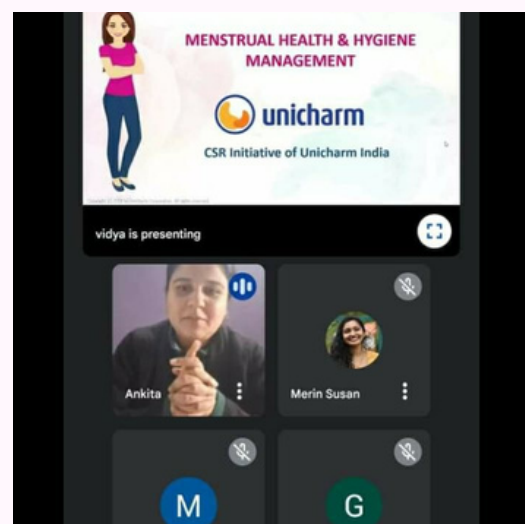

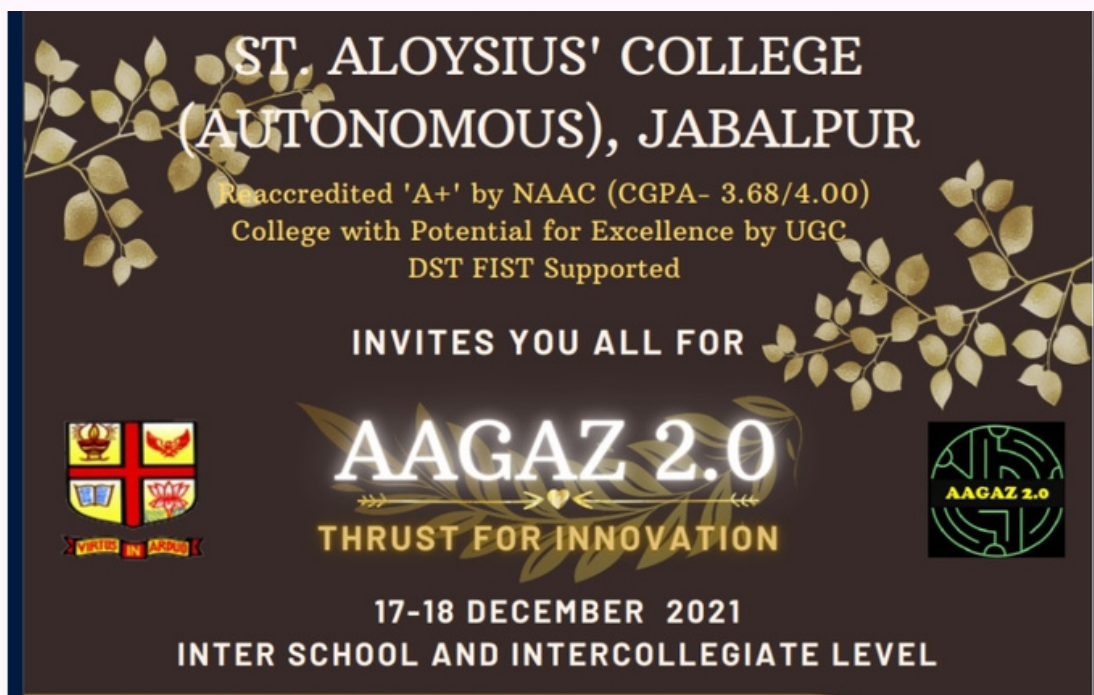
