


Skill development through Study tours: Under the DBT Star Scheme the Bio-Science departments organized educational tours and trips to Regional Science Centre, Bhopal, Rani Avanti Bai Sagar Hydroelectirc Power Plant, National Centre for Biological Sciences (TFIR) Pachmarhi, IISER, Bhopal and Industrial visit to Kareli Sugar Mill, Kareli.

Examination and Results: The College is widely recognized as a leading educational institution and is renowned for promptly announcing all academic results. This year, all undergraduate and graduate level examinations were held offline in response to the Covid-19 outbreak that occurred last year. This session had a total of 1634 students appear in their last year of undergraduate study, while 264 students present in their final year of postgraduate study. 1580 students

graduated from the undergraduate programme, while 54 students were back with supplementary. 264 students earned their postgraduate degrees, while one student left back with an ATKT.

Webinars and Visiting Lecturers: The institution often hosts seminars, conferences, and workshops with the purpose of enhancing the professional development of its teaching staff.

- On July 30-31, 2021, the Department of Economics hosted an online national conference that was sponsored by the ICSSR and focused on the topic of "New Educational Policy: Socio-Economic and Political Implications." There were a total of 335 people there, hailing from various regions all around the country.
- On June 24 and 25, 2022, the departments of Mathematics, Physics, and Computer Science collaborated to host the 3rd Online International Conference on "Advances in Physical, Mathematical, and Computational Sciences." The conference's theme was "Advances in Physical, Mathematical, and Computational Sciences." There were one hundred fifty people there to take part. There were a total of 33 different papers that were delivered.
- On June 28 and 29, 2022, the Department of Hindi hosted a two-day online E-seminar titled "Bhartiyata Ke Sajag Prehri Seth Govind Das." There were a total of 85 attendees, and 20 papers were given as presentations.
- The Research and Development Center hosted a national webinar with the topic of "Intellectual Property Rights: Patent Design and Trademark." The webinar was led by Mr. Sujoy Sarkar, who is based in Kolkata and works at Patent & Design. The Government of India
- The Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) International Webinar was a Side Event of the 9th Annual International Conference on 'Sustainable Development- A Global Initiative of the United Nations,' which was held by the Faculty of Commerce and Management.
- The Research and Development Center hosted a national webinar on the topic of "Intellectual Property Rights: Patent Design Process." The webinar was led by Mr. Bharat N. Suryawanshi, who is in charge of patents and designs at the RGNIIPM in Nagpur.
- A national webinar titled "Awareness of Intellectual Property Rights for Striving Minds" was presented by Dr. Ajay S. Thakur, NIPAM, Patent Office, Mumbai. This webinar was conducted by the Research and Development Center and the IIC.

This year one patent was granted, 02 monographs were published, 03 books viz Indra Bahadur Khare ki Rachnao Mei Mulyabodh, Migrant Labour: Issues and Challenges, and Role of E-Resources and Mind Mastering Strategies in Education were published. One Major Research Project is ongoing and 01 Minor Research Project was granted by the ICSSR. The faculty published 27 International and National research papers, 06 in Scopus Index, 03 in Web of Sciences & 07 in UGC Care List and 39 book chapters. Dr. Rupali Alhuwalia and Dr. Reeta Chouhan completed Harvard Bok Higher Education Teaching Certification, Mrs. Sukhvinder Walia, Dr. Rashmi Patras and Dr. Mary Raymer completed a Professional Certificate course on Adaptive Design for Learning sponsored by United Board for Christian Higher Education conducted by the School of Education and Learning Design, Alteneo Salt Institute, Philippines, and Ms. Bhawana Tekam received the Junior Research Fellowship in Political Science.

Accolades The College was awarded the New Code of Education Award 2022 powered by Wheebox and technology partner Microsoft and Entrall Tech. Among the five categories, the college had been named the winner under Top Digital Enablers in the Autonomous College Category in the innovation of learning.


