Voter Awareness through Poster Competition – (15 October 2022):

Electoral Literacy Club, St Aloysius College Autonomous Jabalpur organized a Poster Competition on the theme '*Matadata Jagrukta*' on 15th October, 2022. The winners were Anam Khan, Diksha Chourasia, Mrinal Jha, Param Kishor Kushram and Aalok Shrivastav.



Voter Awareness Workshop – (15 October 2022):

ELC organized a *Matadata Jagrukta* workshop on 15th October 2022. Booth Level Officer (BLO) from Cantonment Zone assisted students to create Voter ID card. ELC teachers and student executives helped students to create their own Voter ID EPIC card through Voter Helpline App NSVP portal. 150 students benefitted from this workshop.



Voter Awareness through Quiz Competition – (5 November 2022):

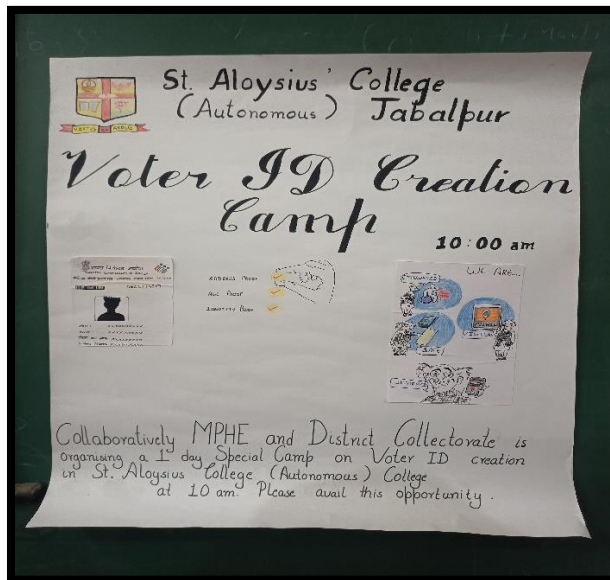
On 5th November 2022 Electoral Literacy Club, St. Aloysius Autonomous College Jabalpur organised a quiz Competition on ‘*Matdata Saksharta*’. 50 students participated and randomly 7 teams were made.

It was held in 5 rounds- elimination, pass it out, buzzer, picture and rapid-fire. The winners were team 5 comprising of Supriya, Khushi Vishwakarma, Sameer Dwivedi, Dishank Upadhyaya, Harsh Patel, Ayush Singh and Unnati Chowdhury. A final written round was conducted for the winners and Supriya stood first amongst them. She participated in the district level quiz competition organised by SVEEP Cell, Jabalpur.



Voter Registration Campaign – (29 November-7 December 2022):

A massive initiative was undertaken by SAC-ELC to locate eligible students (above 18) who did not have a Voter ID card. This was done through Google forms with entries such as name, class, DOB, contact no. Next the students were contacted and assisted on a 1-1 basis to register themselves as voters. SAC-ELC President Ms. Sanya Billa registered a maximum of 79 voters and was felicitated with a certificate. The reference nos. received was sent to SVEEP Cell, Jabalpur on 31st January 2023. Since a record percentage of students were registered SVEEP Cell in its meeting appreciated SAC-ELC.



Voter Awareness through *Nukkad Natak* – (1 December 2022):

SAC-ELC performed a *Nukkad Natak* in the college campus on 1st December 2022. Through the show awareness was created regarding importance of voting, how to register online as a voter, how to purify existing voter ID card, c VIGIL app and different electoral process in a lyrical manner.

Voter Awareness through Role Play – (10 January 2023):

Electoral Literacy Club, St. Aloysius Autonomous College organized a Role Play, on 10th January 2023, on the topic ‘Voter Awareness’. The Role play was based on a conversation between an elderly person and his grand-child. The story line narrated the Pre-independence era, British Rule, Independent India, Right to Vote Parliamentary Bill and the festival of Election-Pride of the Nation.

Epic Card Helpdesk – (30 January-14 February):

A helpdesk was arranged by Electoral Literacy Club, St. Aloysius Autonomous College Jabalpur between 30 January and 14 February 2023, wherein ELC executives helped students and staff to fill form 6,7 and 8. The outcome was 42 new Voter ID cards and 13 revisions.



Community Engagement through Inclusive Election Workshop Baseline Survey – (2-10 May 2023):

To determine the knowledge, attitude and practices of voters in the neighbourhood a baseline survey was conducted by 14 student members of the club between 2-10 May 2023. It helped in identifying reasons for low turnout and accordingly strategies are being planned to address the same.

On 23rd June 2023 a voter registration camp was organised for creation and revision of Voter ID cards. With the support of Cantonment BLO team and ELC helpdesk 12 new Voter ID cards were made and 7 were corrected.
