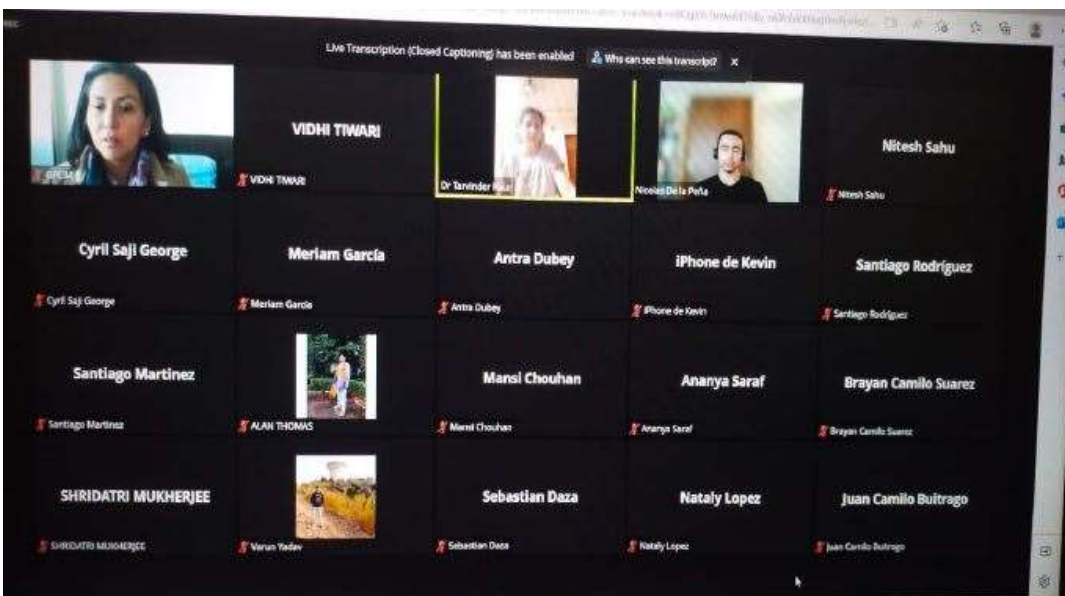
RAKHI MAKING COMPETITION

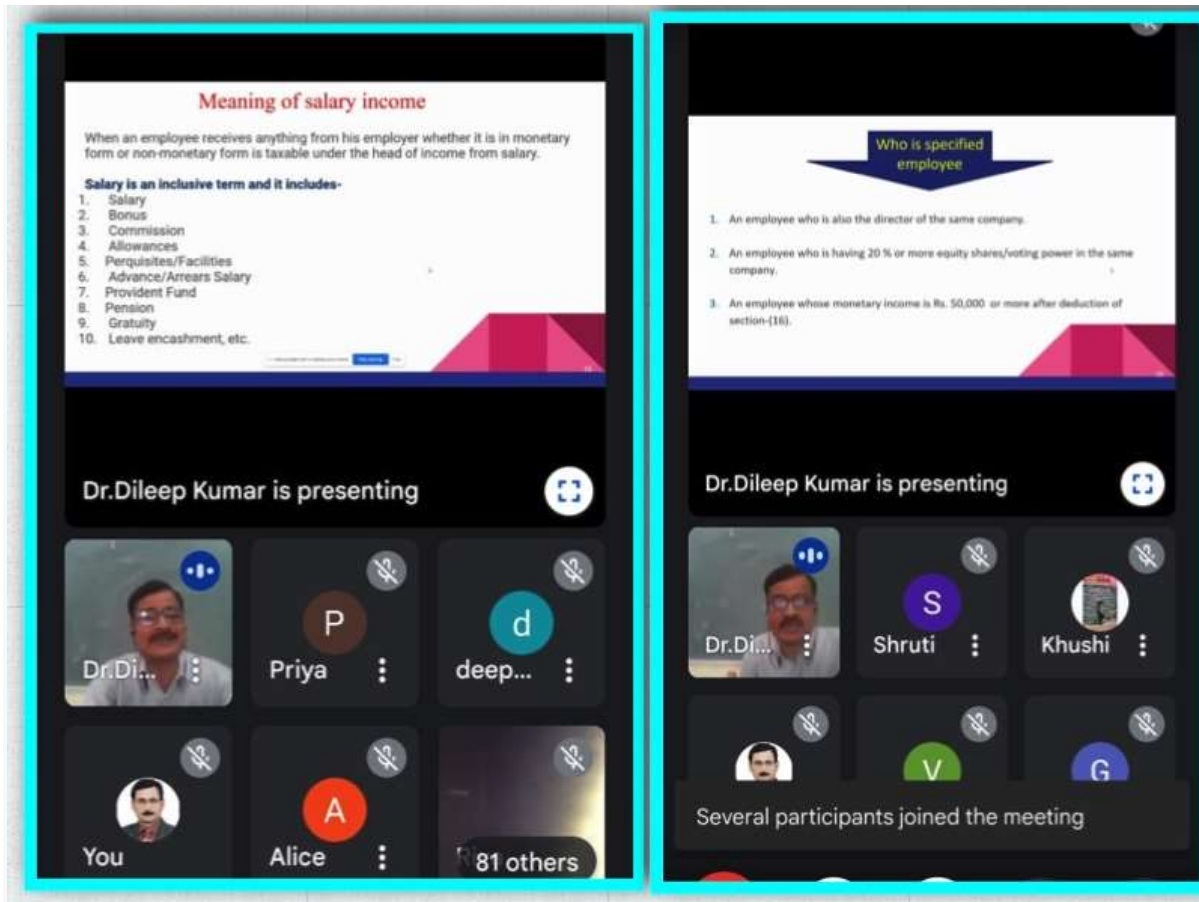

- I Promise to pay Harish Rs. 500 and all fines according to rules.
- I Owe you 500 rs.
- I Promise to pay Jitendra Rs. 1000 on Ram's death provided he leaves me sufficient to pay the said amount.
