- Health and hygiene promotions, including cancer research and dietary health seminars.




- 1. Environmental Initiatives and Protocols: The report details the college's initiatives in enhancing water quality, air purity, and managing hazardous waste effectively.

OBJECTIVES OF GREEN AUDIT


The main aim objective of this green audit is to assess the environmental quality and the management strategies being implemented in College. The team prepares Green Audit Report under three broad features –

Outputs of the Green Audit

Green and clean campus

- Rose Plantation On 26 October, 2021, a Rose plantation was organized by the Department of Botany and Microbiology in collaboration with Nature's Club. The eco-friendly move towards beautiful rose plantation with excellent thought of increasing greenery in campus was successfully done with students. Total seventy five saplings of roses were planted in the college garden.
- A DBT-Star sponsored training program on Bonsai cultivation was organized by the Department of Botany and Microbiology for undergraduate students on 21 March, 2022. The resource person for the training programme was Mrs. Manisha Dubey. Thirty-six students attended the programme.
- For sensitizing our students toward the growing need for water conservation the Department of Management organized a Poster competition on "Save Water" where 2 students showcased the growing need for conservation of water for a secured future.
- Nature Club in Collaboration with Department of Botany & Microbiology & Department of Zoology Organized an e-lecture on "Parthenium: An unwanted living being" on 23rd August 2021 to mark the 16th Parthenium Awareness Week {ICAR - Directorate of Weed Research (DWR)} focusing on making people aware about "Parthenium Free" land development. Best Out of Waste



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
