DETAILS:

A four days national seminar on “*Envisioning a Healthy India: Health, Hygiene, Mother and Child*”, was organized in St. Aloysius’ College (Autonomous) Jabalpur from 21st to 24th February 2019, sponsored by UGC, Bhopal.
