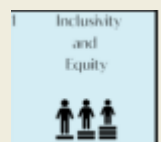

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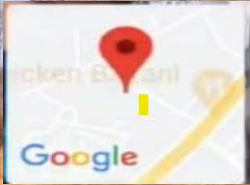

She also described the necessity and strategies of water quality management to assure the overall quality of the product. Methods of water purification were also discussed during the session and were practically shown in working conditions.





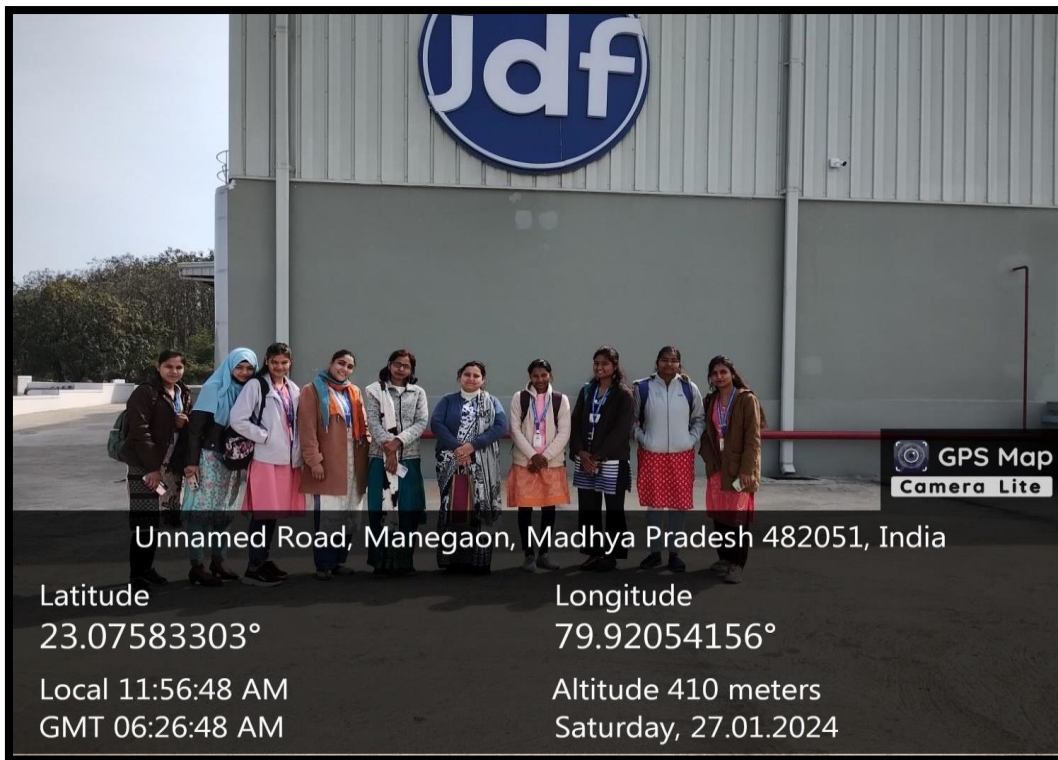

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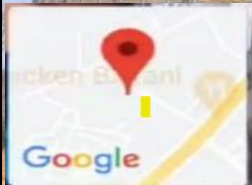

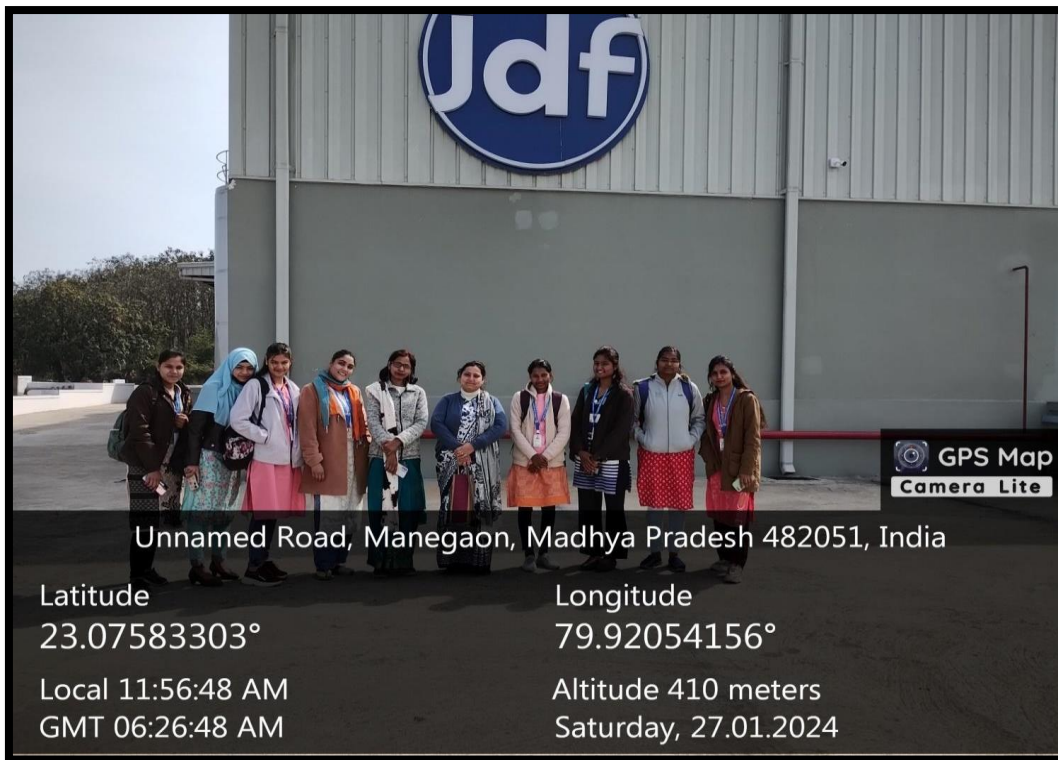
