

- 2. Dr. Smarika Lawrance, Head, Department of Chemistry, St. Aloysius College, (Autonomous), Ahilya BaiMarg, Sadar, Jabalpur (Madhya Pradesh) will be the coordinator for this programme and will submit utilization certificate and statement of expenditure duly signed by him, finance/accounts officer of college and head of college in duplicate at the end of financial year.
- The college is required to implement the programme as per the terms and conditions given in Annexure-I.
- 4. As per "Rule 236 (1) of GFR 2017", the Account of all Grantee Institution or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the institute or Organisation is called upon to do so.
