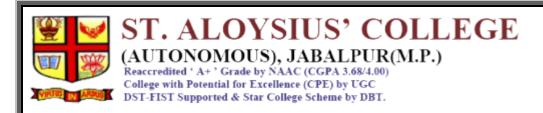
Cleaning the Memorial




Cleanliness And Tree Plantation






Awareness Programme for COVID

The NSS unit of the college organized an awareness programme for COVID precaution. 25 students participated in this programme. The students performed dances and songs to aware the public.

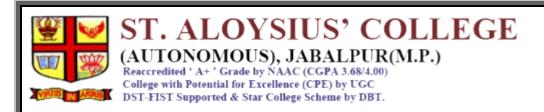




World Ocean Day

NCC Cadets of Naval Unit conducted Puneet Sagar Abhiyan at Gwarighat. Total 36 cadets participated in the event.



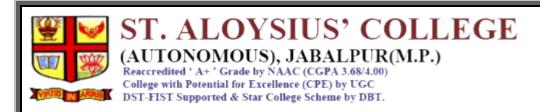


Cycle Rally

NSS Unit of St. Aloysius' College organized cycle rally on 26 February 2022 to spread cleanliness awareness among people.



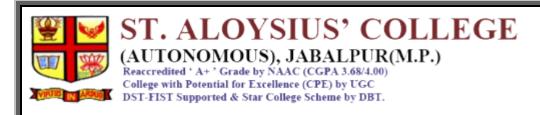

NSS Volunteers participated in Clean India Programme on 2 October 2021 organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra, Jabalpur.






International Day Against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking



Wall Painting Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti

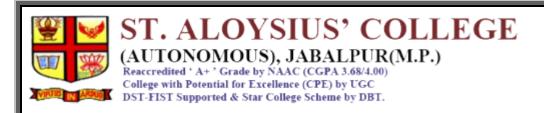

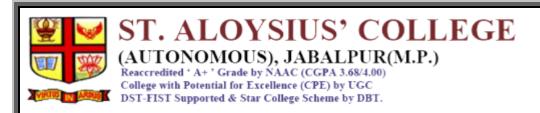


Parakram Diwas

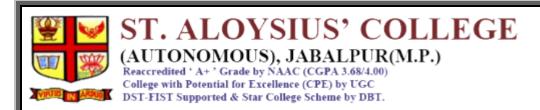



Training Programme for Girl Students








Creative Best Out Of Waste For Empowering Entrepreneurship






Scooter Rally






International Day of Zero Tolerance For Female Genital Mutilation









"Eminent Women Personality: Contribution towards Economy"

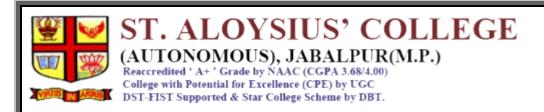


Candle Light March

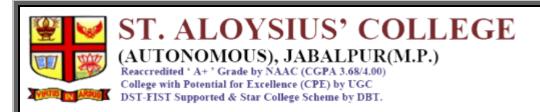




Rally on Save Girl Child

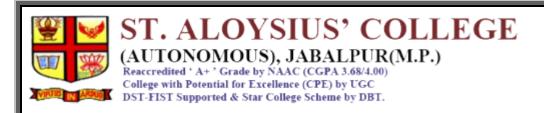




Economic Awareness Program

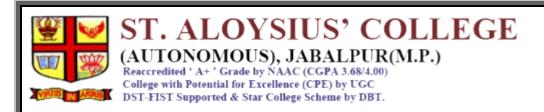




Anti- Cyber Bullying

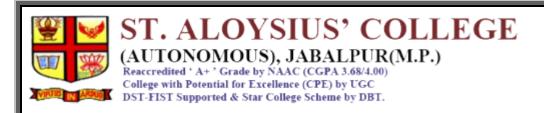




Voting Awareness

World Day of Social Justice


Department of English celebrated the World Day of Social Justice on 25-26 February 2022. The students actively participated in the poster competition and showcased an actively to display the social bias present in the society.













NSS boys unit organized a seven days Special camp from 24 March to 30 March at Jamuniya (Padua) village. 50 students participated in the camp.

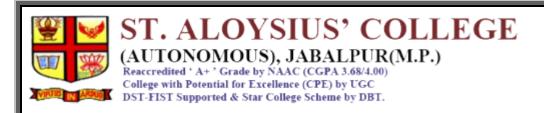


Nukkad Natak
