




GRC Visit [5 August 2023]




Guest Lecture [12 August 2023]






Surya Half Marathon [19 November 2023]






Blood Donation Camp


Cleanliness Drive






Debate Competition on The Occasion of International Youth Day






Mega Blood Donation Camp




Tiranga Yatra


Puneet Sagar Abhiyaan




National Unity Day







Blood Donation Camp




Motivation Talk on the career in Armed Forces






Guest Lecture






Kargil Vijay Diwas






International Day Against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking


Some Aasanas done:

- 5.Tadasana-whole body getting benefited by this posture.




Herbal Tree Plantation



Some medicinal plants planted are:



- 2.ALOEVERA-Aloe Vera has been termed as the 'Plant of Immortality' by early Egyptians. The 'Miracle Plant' is an effective medicinal plant which can be grown at home.
- 3.NEEM-Neem is known as Margosa Tree. The various parts of the neem tree, including the leaves, seeds, and oil, are used for their medicinal properties.
- 4.ASHWAGANDHA-it is a highly lucrative medicinal herb whose application comes again from 3000 years ago and is a vital ayurvedic herb as is natural healing.
- 5.MINT-Mint plants are widely known for the cooling sensation they divulge. In fresh or dried conditions both—they are used as a garnishing in food items.










International Yoga Day






Vaccination Camp




EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT




Save Water Rally







Museum Visit









Candle Light March

Kargil Vijay Diwas








Rally on Save Girl Child




Anti-Plastic Day




Kargil Vijay Diwasv















Water Conservation Day








Cleaning the Memorial


Swachchta Pakhwada

World Earth Day

















International Yoga Day





NCC students conducted Swachtha Pakhwara on 19th September 2019. In this activity 25 students participate






Tree Plantation' My Earth My Duty






Blood Donation Camp






Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat
