




Health Awareness Program on Women Issues






Environment Awareness Programme






Awareness Program on Pollution Control Day


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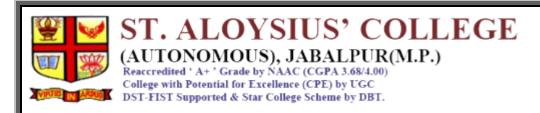





International Youth Day






World AIDS Day Celebration 1st December 2023




Guest lecture






Reel-making competition on with the theme Sanchran ke marg kalank aur bhedbhav on 18th March 2024







Harmony and Happiness









Driving Classes for Girls SHE DRIVES


"Little Sisters Of The Poor, Rimjha"









Rashtriya Ekta Diwas






Zero Tolerance Day






Training Program on Self Defence






Report on Free Eye Checkup Camp






Rastriya kramimukti Diwas








Awareness program on Conjunctivitis




Ecofest


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


Workshop on Importance of wearing a helmet










Awareness Program






Sanitization Awareness Program






Environmental Awareness Program

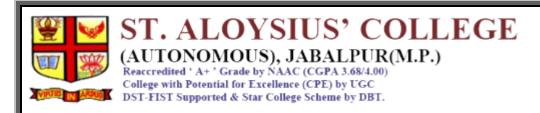




International Women's Day




Visit to Government School, Mehgawan Village






Disease Awareness






Collage Competition




Awareness Program on Water Pollution






Rose Plantation








Economic Awareness Program




Teaching Mathematics in Rural School






Visit to Nirashrisht Virdhashram









Health Awareness Programme






Vedic Maths Course for Girls




Workshop on Sanitizer Making






International Zero Tolerance Day








Dengue Awareness Programme




AIDS Awareness Programme






Tree Plantation


Department of Education organized Plantation on 7 July 2021 in college premises with the aim of promotion of a quality-oriented approach for tree management. 10 students participated.






Visit to Old Age Home

To invoke the feelings of love and compassion in students, the Department of History organized a visit to Old Age Home Rimjha on 25 November 2021. 20 students participated.






Voting Awareness

Department of Political Science conducted Poster Competition to spread awareness on the importance of Voting on 23 February 2022. 25 students participated.






World Day of Social Justice




Befriending the nature National Birds Feeding Week celebrated by Department of Management on 14 February 2022. 20 students participated.






16th Parthenium Awareness Week






World Earth Day








Education Program for Girl Students
















A Webinar on Live to Win....








Creative Best Out of Waste for Empowering Entrepreneurship






Scooter Rally









International Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation









"Eminent Women Personality: Contribution towards Economy"






Visit to Old Age Home








World Health Day






An Awareness Programme for Sensitization on Zero Discrimination Day



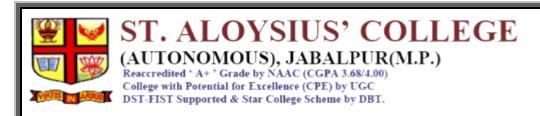


'World Earth Day'






'World Environmental Day'





On the occasion of National Unity Day, Department of Education organised Essay Competition and Pledge with the pupil teachers on 31st October 2019. In this event 50 student participated.






Vertical garden with used disposable bottles



Department of Commerce organised a Poster making and presentation competition on 23rd October 2019 on the topic Pollution free Deepawali. 20 students participated in this event.





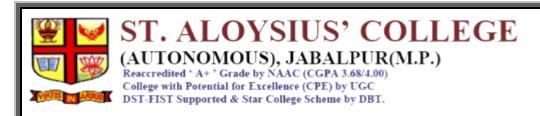





Awareness Health Camp

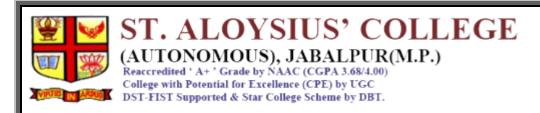




World Mosquito Day


School Teaching






Oath on National Unity

National Unity Day was celebrated at the college by taking a pledge on unity. 200 students participated.







Awareness Programme of World AIDS Day






Visited Snehniketan -School for special children




Swachtha Pakhwada: Skit And Quiz Competition
