






REPORT ON INTER CLASS TABLE TENNIS COMPETITION









Inter Class Football Competition 2022-23




AZADI KA AMRIT MOHOTSAV AT ST. ALOYSIUS' COLLEGE






CREATIVE WRITING COMPETITION






REPORT OF DEBATE COMPETITION



SPOT PAINTING COMPETITION








COLLAGE MAKING COMPETITION


Department of Management
