












REPORT ON INTER CLASS CHESS COMPETITION


















REPORT ON DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM ON WUSHU, TAEKWONDO AND KARATE

This demonstration was organized in the campus so that students can witness the program with their free will and can learn many more things from it apart from academics.






REPORT ON CARTOON MAKING COMPETITION


Wildlife Awareness Week















Report of Samarpan Club




Department of Economics Environment Awareness Program






Department of Management GROUP DISCUSSION and POSTER MAKING (AMA's academic event)
