




SEMINAR ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP ENHANCEMENT






UGC NET CLASSES











WORKSHOP ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT




ALUMNI TALK ON MASTERING THE UGC NET EXAMS



ONLINE GUEST LECTURE ON RESUME BUILDING











GUEST LECTURE ON LIFE SKILLS AND TIME MANAGEMENT









SEMINAR ON VERMICOMPOSTING



CAREER PROSPECTS IN COMPUTER SCIENCE AND APPLICATION


















INVITED TALK ON FUTURE ASPECTS FOR NON-CODER

















ALUMSPEAK
