Situated in sylvan surroundings, the college has a green and clean campus and a climate conducive for rigorous training and learning programs.

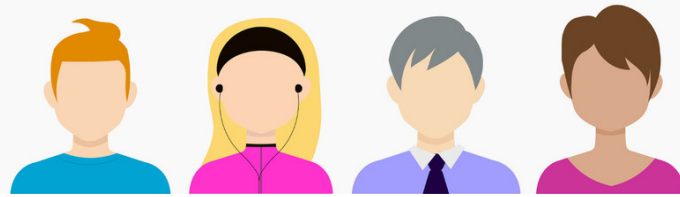
