The aim of Bloom's Taxonomy is to develop and provide a common language for teachers to discuss and exchange learning and assessment methods.

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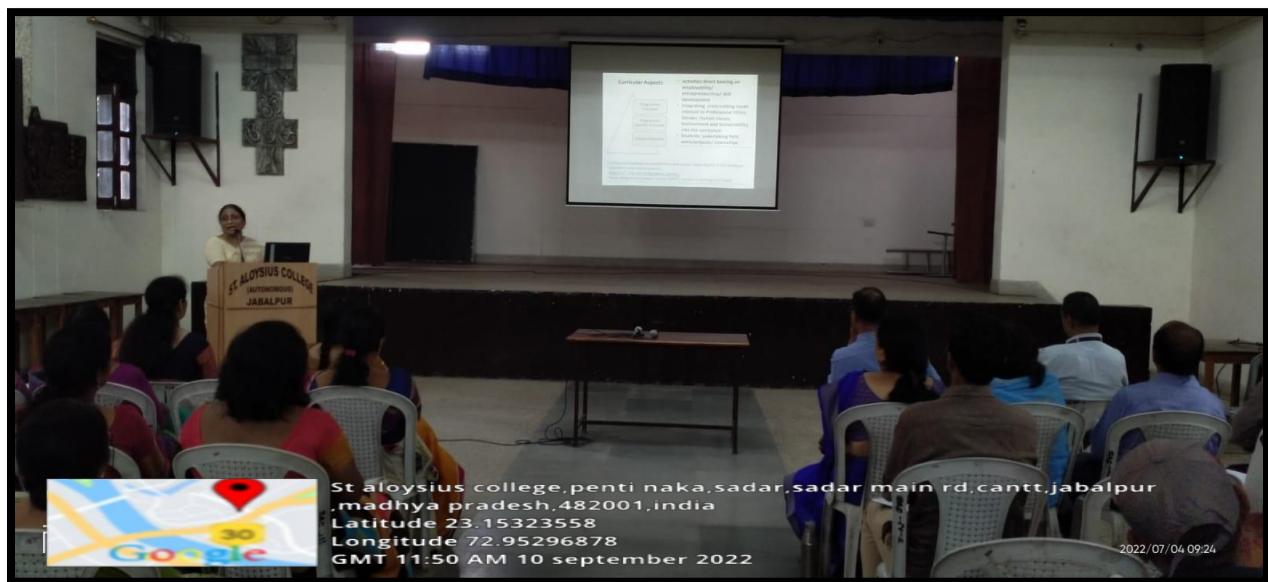
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They also focused upon-
