

The College strives in progress for excellence and frame bench marking milestones for other institutes to follow and adopt. Since 1951, the city stands as true witness to its dynamic and industrious contribution in a variety of fields. The College works to instill professional approach, ethical habits and humanity in the young minds of India.

A remarkable accomplishment of the academic year 2019-20, was that the College has been recognised as one of the leading College by two leading magazines of the country. In Careers' 360 in association with ICFAI (Special Issue on India's Best Universities 2020), March 2020:Vol. XII, Issue 3, published the top-rated colleges listed state-wise where most students first go. We were listed and ranked as number one college in the state of Madhya Pradesh where most students first go. The Knowledge Review, another notable magazine of the country in their special issue on '10 Most Admired Private Universities in India, 2019', ranked the College as one of the 10 most admired colleges of the country.

The College has achieved another benchmark with being as Star College scheme granted by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi. This was granted to improve science teaching, critical thinking, hands on experiment work and participation in summer schools. This year, being the year of Skill Development, was stamped with great academic and co-curricular achievements. We take the privilege to share the distinctiveness of the institution in all spheres.

The College contributes to shaping and honing individuals who will share the burden of the nation's development. The College provides umpteen opportunities to the youngsters for grooming themselves by joining NCC, NSS, clubs and societies. With its magnificent record in NCC, this year too, the cadets of our College made us proud. Four cadets were selected to represent India as the Indian Youth Ambassador namely: Cadet Rohit Pandey visited Russia, Senior Cadet Captain Anjali Ann Joseph visited Kazakhstan, Cadet Sachet Sharan Sund visited Sri Lanka, and Senior Under Officer Aditi Vermavisited Singapore. Senior Under Officer Aditi Verma received the Chief Minister Commendation for the Best Cadet 2019-20 of the Directorate. This year eight cadets represented the MP & CG Directorate in RDC, New Delhi 2020. Six Cadets were selected for NSC 2019 at Vishakhapatnam.

The NSS unit continuously strives to contribute to the good of mankind and also evoke similar emotions amongst the people of society so that they can live in harmony. The NSS unit (boys & girls) organised





The girls unit organised corona awareness rally, conducted independent thinking on social issues like importance of wearing masks, distribution of masks, putting sakoras for birds, using posters for creating consciousness in society to stay home and stay safe during the pandemic.

the realm of sports also, the students represented India and fetched laurels to the institute. The achievements in sports are truly remarkable. To begin with Muskan Kirar represented India at Asian Games 2019 and won silver medal at the games. Divyansh Manoj won a Silver medal in Wushu in an International event. Prajjwal Gupta won a gold medal in Karate, Jayaraj Choudhary won Gold in Flying Kick and Silver in Taekwondo, Yashika Sharma and Anita Devi won bronze medals in Strength Lifting and cycling respectively. In the intercollegiate events the College was winner in Volleyball Men & Women, Chess Men & Women, Table Tennis Men & Women, Badminton Men, Basketball Women. The College won 2 gold and 2 silver medals in shooting, 2 gold, 2 silver, 1 bronze in athletics at state level, 2 gold and 1 silver at All India university level, 1 bronze in cycling at All India University level, 1 silver medal in Wushu at international level and 3 players were selected for nationals in Khelo India Khelo tournament. This year 6 players represented at international, 15 at national, 14 at All India University, 38 at university, 32 at state, and 68 at the district levels.

The College organised a two days NAAC, sponsored National Seminar on "Accreditation, Ranking and Quality: A Paradigm shift for Strategic Enhancement of Higher Education in India" on 8-9 November 2019. In the Inaugural function, the Chief Guest was Prof. Murlidhar G. Chandekar, Vice Chancellor, St. Gadge Baba University, Amravati, and Guest of Honour were Prof. Ranjan Welukar, Former Vice Chancellor, University of Mumbai, Mumbai and Prof. A. Joseph Dorairaj, Former Vice Chancellor, Gandhigram Rural Institute (Deemed tobe University), Tamil Nadu. In the Valedictory function, the Chief Guest was Prof. A.D.N. Bajpai, Former Vice Chancellor, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, and Guest of Honour was Prof. Vijay Fulari, Head, Department of Physics & USIC/CFC, Shivaji University, Kolhapur. In the seminar, twenty-one papers were presented and 10 participated.

The Department of Hindi organised a two days National Seminar on "Rashtrabhasha, Rajbhasha Aur Ab Vishvabhasha Hindi –Vishva Vyapaar Ewam Varnijyake Vishesh Sandharbh Mei", sponsored by ICSSR New Delhi on February 3-4, 2020. In the Inaugural Session, the Chief Guest was Dr. Mridula Sinha (Ex-Governor of Goa) and Guest of Honour was Prof. Kapil Deo Mishra (Vice Chancellor of R.D. University, Jabalpur). Dr. Nutan Pandey (Assistant Director of Central Hindi Directorate, Delhi) delivered the keynote addresses. In the Valedictory session, the Chief Guest was Shri Rahul Dev (Senior Reporter, Delhi) and Guest of Honour was Dr. Deepak Pandey (Assistant Director of Central Hindi Directorate, Delhi). In the two days seminar 150 papers were presented and 350 participated and benefitted.

The College is a pioneer institute in providing opportunities to all teachers and students for honing their skills for all round and continuous growth and progress. All teachers converted the lockdown period into opportunities by organising webinars, FDPs and national - international conferences. The Department of Computer Science organised a conference on "Basics of Cyber Security"; Department of Management on "Effective Ways of Engaging Students during the Lockdown"; Department of English on "English for Digital Fluency in Post Pandemic Era"; Department of Mathematics on "Research Documentation through Latex"; Department of Economics on "Developmental Strategies for Revival of Indian Economy after



COVID 19"; Department of History on "Effective Delivery of Online Content in Social Science"; Department of Hindi on "Gyan Ranjan ki Kahaniyon Mei Abhivyakt Jeevan Darshan"; and the Department of Physics on "Modeling and Experimental Techniques".

The College also took a lead to organise online International and National Conferences. The Faculty of Life Sciences organised a two days online National Conference on "Life Sciences Challenges and Opportunities: COVID – 19 PANDEMIC" on 1-2 June 2020. Eminent speakers were Dr. B.S. Mathapati, Scientist "C", National Institute of Virology, Pune, Prof. Amar Prakash Garg, Vice Chancellor, Shobit University, Meerut, Dr. J. Daniel Chellappa, Senior Scientist, Department of Atomic Energy (India) & Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research, Chennai and Dr. Sameer Shrivastava, Assistant Professor, Department of Biotechnology, Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology, Allahabad. Twelve selected papers were presented and there were 833 participants.

Eleven selected papers were presented and 337 candidates participated.

The Faculty of Physical Sciences organised two days online International Conference on "Advances in Physical, Mathematical and Computational Science" on 12-13 June 2020. Eminent speakers were Dr. Ashish Darbari, U.K. (Founder and CEO at Axiomise Enabling predictable formal verification), Prof. David Levin, Israel (Retired Professor Tel-Aviv University), Ms. Arpita Majumdar (Angstrom Laboratory, Upptala University, Sweden) and Mr. Rajat Swarup, USA (Director of Information Security, Asset Group, Manhattan).Twenty-two quality papers were invited to present from 836 participants.

The Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences organised a two days online National Conference on "Migrant Labour: A Political–Economic-Social-Cultural Perspective" on 26-27 June 2020. Eminent speakers were Prof. Kanhaiya Ahuja, School of Economics, DAVV, Indore, Prof. A. Rangareddy, UGC Emeritus Fellow, Department of Economics, Shri Venkateshwar University, Tirupati, Prof. S. Victor Babu, Head, Department of History, Baba Bhimrao Amedkar Central University, Lucknow, Dr. A.K. Director, Central Directorate for Hindi, MHRD New Delhi. Ten selected papers were invited to be presented and 745 members participated.



The College provides research environment to both teachers and students to grow and upgrade their profiles in keeping with the paradigm shifts worldwide. This year teachers attended 172 international and 425 national conferences and seminars organised in India and outside, 55 chapters were published in books, 55 papers were research papers were published in international and 1 papers at national reputed journals, 04 books were edited; one major and 03 minor research projects were sanctioned by ICSSR.

The Annual Gold Medal and Certificate Distribution Ceremony was conducted on 15 February, 2020. Prof. Kapil Deo Mishra, Vice Chancellor, Rani Durgavati Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur was present as the Chief Guest. On this ceremonious event,44 gold medals and certificates were distributed to the commendable students.

The Annual Social Gathering was organized on the 4 January 2020.Shri Ravindra Kumar Mishra (IAS), Commissioner of Jabalpur Division graced the occasion as the Chief Guest for the gala of cultural events. 




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National Service Scheme

- Volunteers Chhavi Tripathi and Maheshwari were selected for the State camp, which was organized at Narsinghpur and Jyoteshwar respectively.



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
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Department of English "Knowledge isn't power until it is applied."

- International Webinar: An international webinarwas conducted on 24 May 2020 by the




- Department on the topic "English for Digital Fluency in Post Pandemic Era." More than five hundred participants



- The Department of Physics celebrated National Science Day on 28 February, 2020.




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Department of Computer Science and Application

Striving towards excellence the Department of Mathematics always tries to create and avail opportunities to attain scholastic excellence for both faculty and students. Highlights of the Department are as follows:

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

career in Biosciences for senior secondary students. The students were given hands-on fundamental tools and techniques in Botany and tools and techniques in Microbiology.



Department of Biotechnology


Motto: Stride Towards Excellence




Department of Management



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



This year the Placement Cell conducted various training programs and sessions to enhance employability skills of the students in the college, across all the disciplines. Students also participated in the workshops and sessions very enthusiastically. Training activities were scheduled faculty-wise for the students so that sessions could be tailored as per the needs of the students.

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
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Sports Club
