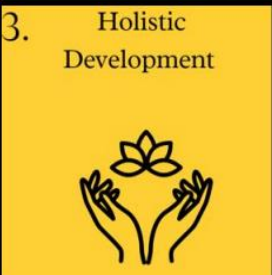
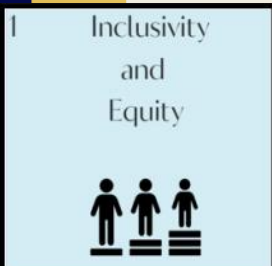

From the Desk of the Principal 2021-22

St. Aloysius' College has been at the forefront of educating formation the young minds of the nation, strengthening their character and preparing them for facing any challenge as they progress ahead in life. The present year had been a year of both challenges and achievements. The College was awarded the Wheebox New Code of Education Award 2022 powered by Wheebox and technology partner Microsoft and Entrall Tech. Among the five categories, the college had been named the winner under Top Digital Enablers in the Autonomous College Category in the innovation of learning.

The College has been a premier institute and known to declare all academics results timely. After the outbreak of Covid-19, this year all UG & PG examinations were conducted via offline mode. A total of 1634 students appeared in Under Graduate and 264 in Post Graduate final year this session. In UG 1580 students graduated and 54 students had supplementary. In PG 264 students post graduated and 01 student had an ATKT.

In the session 2021-22 classes were conducted via online and offline mode. The classroom teaching- learning was resumed and great enthusiasm was witnessed in both the teachers and the taught. "Knowledge has to be improved, challenged and increased constantly or it vanishes" as remarked rightly by Peter Drucker. The College faculty is regularly contributing to research and publishing quality research papers. This year one patent was granted, 02 monographs were published, 03 books viz Indra Bahadur Khareki Rachnao Mei Mulyabodh, Migrant Labour: Issues and Challenges, and Role of E-Resources and Mind Mastering Strategies in Education were published. One Major Research Project is ongoing and 01 Minor Research Project was granted by the ICSSR. The faculty published 27 International and National research papers, 06 in Scopus Index, 03 in Web of Sciences & 07 in UGC Care List and 39 book chapters. Dr. Rupali Alhuwalia and Dr. Reeta Chouhan completed Harvard Bok Higher Education Teaching Certification, Mrs. Sukhvinder Walia, Dr. Rashmi Patras and Dr. Mary Raymer completed a Professional Certificate course on Adaptive Design for Learning sponsored by United Board for Christian Higher Education conducted by the School of Education and Learning Design, Alteneo Salt Institute, Philippines, and Ms. Bhawna Tekam received the Junior Research Fellowship in Political Science.

Under the DBT Star Scheme the Bio-Science departments organised educational tours and trips to Regional Science Centre, Bhopal, Rani Avanti Bai Sagar Hydroelectric Power Plant, National Centre for Biological Sciences (TFIR) Pachmarhi, IISER, Bhopal and Industrial visit to Kareli Sugar Mill, Kareli, the college regularly organizes seminars, conferences and workshop for the upskilling and improvement of faculty members. The Physical Sciences departments organised a collaborative International Conference on "Advances in Physical,



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Mathematical and Computational Sciences” on 23-24 July 2022. There were 198 participants. The Department of Economics organised an ICSSR sponsored Online National Conference on “New Educational Policy: Socio-Economic and Political Implication” on 30-31 July 2021. A total of 335 participants attended from different parts of the country.

The Department of Management in collaboration with the Department of Commerce, organised an International E-Conference on “Sustainable Development” on 22 September 2021. Hundred participants benefitted from e-conference. The Department of Management organised a two days International Faculty Enrichment Programme under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), on “Towards Enhanced Digitalization: Mentoring the Mentors” from 3-4 December, 2021. A total of 138 participants attended the enrichment programme.

The Department of English organised a National E-Seminar on "Tribute to Khushwant Singh: A Writer of Protean Sensibilities" on 3-4 September 2021. Ninety-eight contributors and participants across nation attended it. The Department of Chemistry conducted a two days' workshop on “Benchmarking Skill Development” on 29- 30 October 2021 as a faculty development programme for school teachers. It was attended by twenty five teachers from the district. A Webinar on Star College Scheme by the Department of Biotechnology, New Delhi: “Mentor Mentee Scheme” was also organised on 14 May 2022 for regional and peer institutions. Both the initiatives were conducted under the banner of DBT Star College Scheme.

The Department of History conducted an E-Seminar on “India's Independence and Contribution of Freedom Fighters” on 14 August 2021. It was attended by 146 participants. The Department of Botany & Microbiology conducted a workshop on “Hydroponic: Practices & Benefits” in collaboration with Bio design Innovation Centre on 22 January 2022 to enlighten students about hydroponics, its farming and its advantages. Thirty three participants attended the workshop.

The 3rd Online International Conference on “Advances in Physical, Mathematical and Computational Sciences” was organised by the departments of Mathematics, Physics and Computer Science on 24-25 June 2022. It was attended by 150 participants. A total of 33 papers were presented. The Department of Hindi organised a two days online E-seminar on “Bhartiyata Ke Sajag Prehri Seth Govind Das” on 28-29 June 2022. There were 85 participants and 20 papers were presented.

“Victories in life come through our ability to work around and over the obstacles that cross our path”. It gives me immense pleasure to share that this year our college students have brought international acclaim to the College. Muskan Kirar (B. A III) played World Championship September 2021, USA and won silver medal. She played World Cup Stage I, Antalya, Turkey, World Cup Stage II Shanghai, China and won Bronze Medal, selected for World Cup Stage III Paris, France and World Games Birmingham, USA. 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Mansoori (B.Com Hons. I) participated in 1st International All Style Martial Arts February 2022 and won Silver Medal in Kumite Event. In Khelo India University Archery Games 2022 under the category of mixed teams, Chirag Vidyarthi (B.Com I) and Muskan Kirar together won silver medal; Shivansh Awasthi (B.Com III), Aditya Upadhyay (B. A III) and Chirag Vidyarthi and won gold medal in compound category; Muskan Kirar won bronze medal in team event category. Seyad Faizan (B.Com II) participated in All India University Games 2022 and Khelo India University Archery Games. Aditi Shrivastava (B.Com II) participated at All India University Wushu Championship 2022 and in 19th Junior National Wushu championship in March 2021 and won two bronze medals and a Silver Medal in Kungfu Wing Chun Event.

Ashutosh Soni (B.Com III) participated in 30th Senior National Wushu Championship December 2021 and won Gold Medal in the Group Event. Ayush Kosta (B.Com I) participated at 14th Senior National Dodgeball Championship October 2021 and secured second Position. Mitali Yadav (B.B.A.I) participated in 4th Open National Taekwondo Championship December 2021 and won Silver Medal in -49 kg Weight category. Kartik Sharma (B.Com II) participated in 22nd Sub-Junior and Senior National Wushu Championship November 2021 and won Gold Medal in Nanquan Event. Yashika Sharma (B.Com III) participated in 31st National Strength. Lifting & Incline Bench Press Championship December 2021 won Gold Medal and broke the record of 150 kg weight of the year 2016 while lifting 155 kg weight in +80 weight category. Eighty students participated at district, at State level 53, at National level 22, at University level 34, at All India University level 19, at Khelo India University 05 and at International level 02.

The College teams participated in various Intercollegiate sports events and were winners in Volleyball (men), Table Tennis (women), Chess (men) and badminton (men). The college teams were runners up in Basketball (women), Kabbadi (men), Football (men), Cricket (men), Chess (women) and 2 Golds in Judo.

The students also excelled in co-curricular activities. Ishita Vishwakarma of B.A II year was 1st runners up in a National television competition India's Got Talent 2022. In NCC, SUO Anushri Shrivatsava represented MP & CG Directorate at RDC 2022 at New Delhi. She marched for the PM's Rally and was part of Rajpath Contingent too. Leading Cadet Ishika Gurjar was part of the prominent Pre -RDC 2022 held in Bhopal. Cadet Sanskar Satish Jain had a lifetime experience of visiting five countries viz Saudi Arabia, Oman, Egypt, Djibouti and Eritrea on board naval ships like INS Sujata, INS Tir, ICG Sharthi.

Honouring the "Swarnim Vijay Varsh" the glorious 75 years of India's independence, one of the victory flame lit by the Prime Minister of India arrived at the College and the NCC unit of the college had the incredible honour of receiving the glorious victory flame, incarnating exemplary valor and sacrifice of our resolute forces in safeguarding the nation.



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“Giving back to society and community enriches our lives, making it a double blessing”, said Kellie Sullivan. The College organized programmes like health & hygiene, defence training programme for girl, vedic maths, sanitizer making workshop, awareness drive for crime & violence against women & cancer, training on website designing and martial arts, nukkad natika, plantation drive, Celebration of social justice day etc.

In this session, the Annual Social Gathering was conducted on the 23 December 2021 via a digital platform. It was an attempt to engage students in cultural activities during the pandemic and entertain them virtually. The entire gathering was streamed online.

The Annual Gold Medal ceremony was conducted on December 4, 2021. Chief Justice Sanjay Yadav, former Chief Justice High Court of Allahabad & an ex-student of the college was present as the Chief Guest along with Right Rev. Gerald Almeida, Bishop Catholic Diocese of Jabalpur as the Chairperson of the ceremony. Meritorious students were awarded gold medals in this auspicious ceremony. Forty Seven medals were awarded. Also, teachers who had completed 25 years of their services in the institute were presented token of appreciation for their dedicated services.

The Annual Prize distribution for co-curricular activities was conducted on March 29, 2022. Most Rev. Gerald Almeida presided as the Chairperson of the function along with the Principal. Certificates for extra- curricular, NCC and NSS were distributed to students for the session.

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Sports Report

- The highlights for the session 2021-22 are as follows:
- This year the inter collegiate tournament started with the Cycling Competition dated 21 November, 2021 in which four of our students participated and one student was selected for the All India University level.
- In December a number of sports events were organised. First was the Basketball (women) tournament from 2-4 December, 2021, our college team played the final against UTD RDVV but unfortunately lost and stood runners up. Four girls were selected for district, state and inter university level.
- From 4-6 December, 2021 volleyball (men) tournaments organised by UTD RDVV in which we stood winners. Six students were selected for district, state and inter university Level.
- From 8-10 December, 2021 Kabaddi (Men) tournament was organised by Shree Jankiraman College, thirty four teams participated. The college played the final against UTD RDVV and stood runners up. Two students were selected for district level and one for state and university level.
- From 9-11 December, 2021 badminton tournament was organised by Govt. Mahakuashal College Jabalpur and our team was the winner. Two students were selected for district, state, and inter university level.
- From 13-15 December, 2021 football (men) tournament was organised by UTD RDVV. Our team played the final against G S College and our college were runners up. Four students were selected for district, state university and as the football (men) team qualified this year in the west zone all four boys went for the All India University Tournament.
- From 13-15 December, 2021 Kabaddi (women) tournament, was organised by Shree Jankiraman College, thirty two teams participated, our college played the final against UTD RDVV and were runners up. Two students were selected at district level and one for university level tournament. From 16-17 December, 2021 was the table tennis (women) tournament organised by the Govt. Science College. Our girls team played in the final against the Govt. Science College and were the winners. Two were selected for district level and one for inter university level.
- From 23-24 December, 2021 Inter District Athletics Tournament was organised by UTD RDVV. The college team bagged two gold, five silver, and four bronze medals. Two of our boys were selected for the state and All India athletics tournament.
- On 24 December, 2021, there was an archery tournament in which we won four gold medals. Four students were selected for the All India University tournament where Muskan Kirar (B.A. III Year) won two gold medals and one



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silver medal, Shivansh Awasthy (B.Com. III Year) got one silver medal, Chirag Vidhyarthi (B.Com. I Year) got one silver medal, and Aditya Upadhyay (B.A. III Year) got one bronze medal and also got selected in Khelo India University Games 2022. There all the three boys won gold medals and Muskan Kirar won one silver medal.

- From 31 December, 2021 to 1 January, 2022 chess tournament was organised by Govt. College Barela where our men's team stood winner and women's team stood runners up. Four boys and one girl were selected for the Inter University Tournament. The girls' team qualified in the West Zone this year and participated in the All India University Tournament and stood at seventh rank among all the fifteen qualified teams.
- In the month of January from 3-7 Inter Collegiate Cricket (men) tournament was organised by Govt. Science College. The college was runners up.
- On 28 January, 2022 Inter Collegiate Judo Competition was organised by UTD RDVV in which our college won two gold medals. Two boys were selected for the All India University Tournament and one was selected for Khelo India University Games 2022 among the two
- On April 4, 2022 the Power Lifting competition was organised. Two of our students participated and won gold medals and both were selected at All India University Level. The inter district tournament was organised by UTD RDVV.

- Shivansh Awasthi (B.com. III Year) and Aditya Upadhyay (B.A. III Year) won gold medal, Chirag Vidhyarthi (B.com. I year) won gold and one silver medal, and Muskaan Kirar (B.A. III year) won silver and one bronze medal at Khelo India University Archery Games 2022.

Department of English
