By bringing the vaccination process directly to the college, the Women's Cell and NSS aimed to ensure that all students had the opportunity to be vaccinated, thereby promoting wider immunization coverage.



Program on "Vedic Mathematics".


Objective: To empower female students with skills in "Vedic Mathematics" to simplify complex mathematical problems.

Objective: To motivate the students to establish an Egalitarian society.


Date: 22nd September 2022

Driving Classes: "SHE" Drives


Objective: to promote independence and holistic growth among female.

Objective: to create entrepreneurship skills in sanitizer and soap making.


Date: 6th November to 7th November 2022

Celebration of National Unity Day


Objective: to understand and take pledge for unity and integrity.

Entrepreneurship Skill Development Program on "Website Designing and development"


Objective: to make female students as Web developer

Objective: to make female students skillful in hardware maintenance and installation


Date: 04th to 5th February 2023


International Zero Tolerance Day- Essay Competition
