The cell works with the mission "The Women Cell shall strive to create a better and just society by empowering women."

The vision of the cell is "To make the cell a unique platform for the development of its members, by providing them opportunities to contribute towards the betterment of the society."

The cell works with the following objectives:

- To make students aware of Gender Equity.
- To help students to change their mindset and attitudes towards life in terms of women
- To encourage greater participation and to develop responsible and value oriented leadership in Female students.

- Grievance related to charging of fees



- Grievance regarding conducting of Examinations

- Girls are made aware of laws and by-laws by organizing lectures of eminent judges, lawyers and police personnel and awake the girl students for their privileges and duties.

The institutional Grievance Redressal Cell addresses the grievances of students as follows:

- A suggestions box placed at a strategic point in the college where students can drop their grievances. The suggestion box is opened weekly and then scrutinized.
- After which they are forwarded to the Principal.
- Principal takes the necessary action to resolve the grievances within a week.
- Students can approach the Principal for their grievances personally or through e-mail.
- A meeting of the Grievance Redressal cell is held every four months. The grievances are categories as academic and administrative and as per their categorization they are numbered and entered in the Grievance Redressal register.

Anti-harassment committee: This committee took all the preventive measures to prevent sexual harassment and resolved related issues. The Women's cell and Equal opportunity center assist in creating awareness on gender equality and inculcating a sense of responsibility towards upholding the dignity and welfare of women. - iii) Cultural: The cultural committee comprises of 90%-woman staff who motivate and prepare women student for competing in cultural events at all levels.
- iv) NCC and NSS girls units: There are two NCC girls' units (Naval and Army) and one NSS girls' unit. Various programmes are organized aiming the female students to make them sensitize towards the issues of women foeticide, AIDs awareness and the girls are motivated to join these units
- v) Ladies Room: Provision is made for girls resting mode in ladies room. There is an adequate place and silence is maintained for girls to study. This room is also equipped with Television, Water cooler and Sanitation Machine.
- vi) Girls Washroom: The washrooms for girls have been refurbished with modern amenities with clean environment. All the facilities are available in the Girls' Washroom.
- vii) Girls Hostel: The ladies hostel is provided with enhanced accommodation, adequate space, ambience and good location. The rules and regulation of Ladies Hostel are strictly implemented and students follow the same.

- The ambience of women Hostel is much secured.
- To ensure students participation in the housekeeping of the hostel and to maintain discipline, the students' representatives are appointed.
- The warden Sr. Mercitta of the hostel provides home like atmosphere to the girls.
- The students of the hostel celebrate basically all festivals like Holi, Diwali, Id, Christmas, Onam and others and the management of the hostel provides all the support for organizing these programmes.
- e) Hostel management takes the responsibility for the sick students, provide the vehicle to take the student to the hospital and also accompany them.
- Security guard is present for 24 hrs.
- Indoor and outdoor game facilities are provided in the hostel like caroms, chess, badminton court, table tennis court etc.
- h) Other facilities include the hostels are provided with 10 PCs with wi-fi internet connection to be used by the girls. It is fitted with solar heaters for hot water supply.

The Following Activities Were Conducted In The Year 2020-21:

Activities promoting gender equity and sensitization

A two days Training Program on 'Hardware Course for Girls' for girl students was

Day 2- Practical demonstration of the arrangements of hardware inside CPU, identifying faults, assembling the system.

Outcome- Skilled to assemble the PCs', faults detection and handling trouble shooting.

The objectives of the workshop were to provide to make the girl students more creative and productive, to develop interest and awareness of drawing and painting and to develop inner qualities of students.







- The Women Cell in collaboration with Department of Mathematics organized Oneday Education Program for girls students on the topic "VEDIC MATHS COURSE" on 18th December 2020. The objectives of the event was
 - to make the students aware about Vedic mathematics and tricks, so that one can solve complex problems much easily and efficiently.
 - to enable faster calculation as compared to the conventional method.
 - to give better understanding of mathematic and increase creativity and confidence in them to promote women empowerment.

- 16 sutras (formulae) and 13 sub-sutras (sub-formulae) which can be used for problems involved in Arithmetic, algebra, geometry, calculus, conics etc.

Outcome of the Program was If nearly in future some confusion may occurred in oriented method of Mathematics solving, student can approach the same problem by Vedic method and it also improves the spiritual side of the student's personality. Solving problems and sum by Vedic method is much easier and quick by which student will be benefitted in the competitive exams.

4. Women Cell organized one day Webinar on "Decoding the mind-body connection of Women in India" in collaboration with Sarvpriye Foundation, New Delhi on 16th January, 2021. The aim of the webinar was to create awareness among the students on the present scenario of health and hygiene of women in India. The resource persons were Dr. Veena Gupta, Oncologist, New Delhi and Mr. Sandeep, Certified trainer from Gold's & Ace (American Council on Exercises). Dr. Veena Gupta and Mr. Sandeep oriented the students on good menstrual hygienic practices such as the use of sanitary napkins; washing and cleaning; how to dispose of sanitary napkins, followed by precautions to be taken during the period, and dietary habits, so, as to enable them to lead a healthy reproductive life in future. The Students of the college attended this Webinar. It was a very interactive session.



It is found that St. Aloysius College has attained gender balance in its system. Strengths & Gender Sensitive initiatives in the Institute are:


