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



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


Yoga and Meditation Classes for Stress Management

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


Awareness Program on "Self-Finance Management"



Impact: An awareness program on self-finance management had a positive impact on participants in managing financial well-being by providing them with the knowledge and tools to make sound financial decisions





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

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Awareness Program on Health and Hygiene for Non-teaching Staff


Date: 16th January 2024

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
