Expert talk on "Recent Trends in Computer Science and Job Opportunities" and "Eras of English Literature"




Online Research Paper Presentation on Various Aspects of Privatisation







Expert talk on Soft Skill





Expert talk on Life Skills and Time Management







Webinar on "Scope of Business Analytics"




Training Program on Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme







Webinar on "Business Communication & Employability Skills"


