
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



LinkedIn Profile Management and Development

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

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Awareness Program on Honeybee Keeping

Date: 18th May 2023

Report: St. Aloysius College, Department of Zoology, Botany, and Microbiology, with the collaboration of Jawaharlal Nehru Agriculture University (JNAU), Jabalpur under the Environmental Sustainability Plan, NAHEP, and CAAST, organised a one-day workshop on "Honeybee Keeping" on May 18, 2023. The inaugural session began with the prayer song by the Aloysian choir of the college, followed by the address of Rev. Dr. G. Vazhan Arasu, Principal, St. Aloysius College (Autonomous), Jabalpur, where he warmly welcomed all the guests, eminent speakers, and participants. Dr. Anjali D'Souza, Vice Principal Academics, in her welcome address, focused on four qualities of honeybees that everyone should imbibe in them: teamwork, selfless contribution, adaptation, and preparation ahead like honeybees. Dr. S.B. Das, Professor and Head, Deptt. of Entomology, Nodal Officer JNKVV, Jabalpur, briefed about the programme on beekeeping. The workshop consisted of eight theme-based lecture sessions. The renowned speakers were Dr. Abhishek Shukla, Professor and DI, Deptt. of Entomology, JNKVV, Jabalpur, Dr. A.K. Saxena, Professor, Deptt. of Entomology, JNKVV, Jabalpur. 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


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

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
