

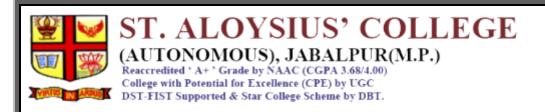

Banners promoting the ban of plastics are displayed across the campus, encouraging environmental responsibility.







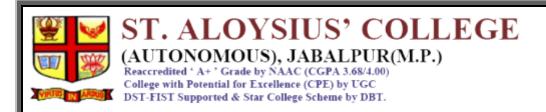

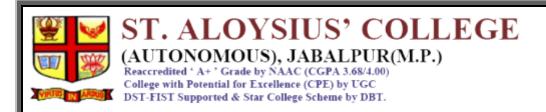


Awareness Programme on Ban of Plastic in Campus and beyond






Awareness campaign on "Say No to Plastic, Save the World"






Cleanliness drive

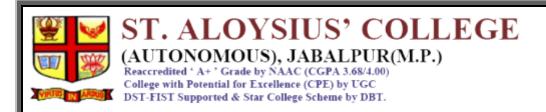


Slogan-making competition on "Beat Plastic Pollution,"
