






Certificate / Vocational Program on Vermicomposting

Every year, the Department of Zoology organizes a certificate course on vermicomposting, which has been expanded into a vocational program under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The course emphasizes environmental responsibility and promotes waste reduction, supporting the college's commitment to sustainability and equipping students with practical skills in waste management. Additionally, these educational programs are extended beyond the campus to teach villages about producing organic manure. Recently, the department has also begun offering consultancy for internship programs in vermicomposting to students from other Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), thereby spreading its expertise and sustainable practices to a broader student base.




Event Highlights:






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Report on Agriculture Startups Awareness Program in Association with JNKVV, Jabalpur

- 2. Targeted Workshops: Offer detailed workshops that focus on specific areas of agricultural entrepreneurship.



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


Event Highlights:

- Street Play: A street play titled "Go Green" was performed, promoting proactive environmental protection and sustainable practices.









Event Highlights:


