


Impact: The NCC cadets developed practical skills in tree planting and ecosystem restoration, learning about the importance of selecting appropriate species and planting techniques.



Impact: Strengthened community engagement and collaboration in promoting environmental initiatives.






Making Pit for Composite Manure – Sustainable Environment

Date: 25 August 2019

Report: The NSS unit of St. Aloysius' College undertook a significant initiative by digging a pit approximately 4 feet deep at Pipariya Kala. The purpose of this endeavour was to provide a sustainable solution for managing organic waste, specifically vegetable and fruit peels, within the local community. The pit dug by the NSS unit serves as a designated site for collecting organic waste materials, such as vegetable and fruit peels, from households in Pipariya Kala. By encouraging the local people to deposit their organic waste into the pit, the NSS unit aimed to promote the conversion of this waste into nutrient-rich compost or manure through natural decomposition processes. This initiative aligns with the principles of waste management and environmental sustainability, as it reduces the generation of harmful greenhouse gases from organic waste decomposition in landfills and contributes to the production of organic fertilizers for agricultural purposes.

Impact: Increased understanding among NSS volunteers about the significance of organic waste management and its impact on environmental sustainability.






Nukkad Natak - Safe and Clean Environment

Date: 26 September 2019


