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Cleanliness Drive – Awareness Program

Date: 12 November 2021

Report: The NCC Army wing of St. Aloysius' College Jabalpur orchestrated a rally on November 12, 2021, to raise awareness about water conservation. Cadets and NCC staff members, totalling around 50 participants, actively engaged in disseminating messages centered on the principles of Jal Shakti Abhiyan. The rally commenced at the clock tower and traversed through various parts of the city, aiming to reach a broad audience. During the rally, Commanding Officer Col. Amit Gupta addressed the participants, highlighting the pressing issue of groundwater depletion exacerbated by consecutive deficient monsoons in the district
