Paper Bag Making – Plastic Bag Free Day

Date: 3 July 2023

Report: On Plastic Bag Free Day, the Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) organized an event in Khamariya village with the theme "DON'T BE DRASTIC, SAY NO TO PLASTIC." Students from St. Aloysius College spearheaded an awareness campaign advocating for the use of paper bags instead of plastic ones. The campaign emphasized the need to move away from the habitual use of plastic bags and outlined the environmental and health benefits of switching to paper bags. About 9 students took part in the initiative, working together with 10 rural women to craft bags from newspapers.

Impact: Participants, including students and rural women, gained a deeper understanding of the harmful effects of plastic bags on the environment and human health.

Date: 27 December 2022
