However, communal riots in India occur due to differences between religious communities. These turn incredibly violent and gruesome. Communal harmony is a prerequisite for a country like India, with its diverse population and cultures. Communal harmony ensures that every religion gets equal treatment, and tolerance builds amongst citizens. Some people are still stuck on 'Jantwad' and 'Hindu Muslim' fight.

Because of some narrow minded people, India is still lacking in development. I personally think more than external development we should focus on inner development. COMMUNAL HARMONY AND NATIONAL INTEGRATION IN INDIA

Meaning of National Integration and Communal Harmony:

National Integration refers to the perception of single national identity among people of a country belonging to various races, castes and religion.

Communal Harmony refers to the harmony, acceptance and love among the people of various communities belonging to different castes, races and religion.

Communal Harmony is the most important pre-condition for feeling of Unity and National Integration in India.

Introduction:

From time Immemorial, it has been seen that different races fought battles against each other on Indian soil and got themselves firmly entrenched, but India has assimilated them all into her blood. The conflicting cultures were at last moulded by this country to be her own genesis and pattern.

India has witnessed a great diversity of faith and religion from the earliest times, but this has not interfered with the peaceful pursuit of the ways of life of different sections. Christians and Jews who came to India in the first century of the Christian era found hospitable reception here. After several centuries, the Parsis and Muslims received equal reception. Ever since then, India has been marked by the prosperity of communities belonging to different religions. The people of India values the importance of National Integration.

The dictum of catholicity of Indian Culture, 'live and let live', have been forged through ages, different religious races and cultures of the vast country into a united concept of oneness that is

National Integration and Communal Harmony

National Integration is the bond and togetherness between people regardless of their caste, creed, religion or gender. It is the feeling of oneness, brotherhood and social unity under common unity and society in a country. National integration helps to the people of a country unified and strong from within despite the diversities. Communal harmony is the principle of peace and harmony existing amongst various religious communities, free from violence and hatred. It involves tolerance and respect for each other's belief such that non-violence prevails. If we want to preserve or keep intact the national integration of the country, we should curb the ugly head of anti integration for it. It is Usha Patel who has aptly said 'Sare Jahan Se Achha Ek Hindustan Mahan, Hum Bhal Hai iski ye gulfshan Hema'. There is no better land than Hindustan Mahan, Gaudhi said. 'Let us forget all thoughts of I am a Hindu, you a Muslim or I am a Gujarati, you a Madia, let us think, I and mine in a common Indian nationality, we shall be free only when a large number of us people are determined to swim or sink together.' Here are some examples of Communal Harmony in India. There are a many examples but I have selected few of them here are they - In Delhi, United Sikhs, an organization that provides humanitarian aid, has also come in with water. 'We brought only water, but people said that this too,' says Jaspal Singh, when citizens gave of whatever they could. The coronavirus pandemic was, in many ways, a test for the possibility of a non-sectarian nationalism. Indians as one nation had to come together, stay home, applied health workers said would have been but that was short-lived. The Tablighi Jamaat congregation in Delhi's Nizamuddin Market, from where more than 100 positive cases of coronavirus have emerged, would be a legitimate topic of utmost concern in any country. And it definitely shouldn't have taken place when a pandemic was claiming lives on the thousands. Yet, the manner in which it was cynically exploited to stoke naked communalism, on social media and TV channels, had a singular aim to give a communal colour to the fight against coronavirus. Farmer's protest in India is going strong and will be staying that way in the upcoming months. With thousands of people protesting on the borders of New Delhi along with millions of people in the entire country protesting against the new farm bills, religious groups such as the Muslims in the country are doing their job to serve the farmers 25 men of the Muslim Federation of Punjab, led by Farooq Mahesan, came to the Singh border to serve the farmers that feed ourselves. Another example when Santosh Singh lost his life to a terminal disease, his friend Razaq Khan Tikari, a Muslim, performed his last rites following all Hindu rituals. He set a very touching example of how religion can serve as a barrier when it comes to true brotherhood. Razaq is a resident of Chhattisgarh, and he had been friends with Santosh for many years. Santosh and his family were not even well off. After Santosh's death, Razaq also helped his friend's wife financially. At thousands of women celebrated Amalika Pongal by making offerings in marketplace, a church and a mosque opened their doors for the people to help them set up the stove inside their compounds. The St. Joseph Cathedral and the Palayam Jama Masjid set a brilliant example of communal harmony. There are millions on example I can write but only one example is enough to for a person to believe in communal harmony and change their thinking.
