


## **SAC-Inter-Religious Forum: Communal Harmony**






## **Clean College and Green College**

## Ped Lagao Abhiyan (Tree Plantation Campaign)


Date: July 25, 2019

- Creative Activities: Various games and cultural activities, including dance and singing, were organized for school students to encourage creativity and goal-setting, with 25 students participating enthusiastically.






### **Guruparb Celebration at St. Aloysius College**

#### **Distinguished Guests and Themes:**


Chief Guest: Shri Jagat Bahadur Singh, Mayor of Jabalpur, who emphasized the importance of universal brotherhood and peace in his address.
