
Aloysian Management Association Fest ("Unleashing Managerial Brilliance: Cultivating a Culture of Innovation!")


The college newsletter published by the students of Dept. of English vol.1 and vol.2 were released by Dr Fr Ben Anton Rose, Vice Principal.


