
#### **Voters Awareness Program**




#### Social Awareness Program – Visit to KARUNA Orphanage



#### Social Awareness Program – Visit to Sneh Niketan School


Date: 31/08/2019


## Constitutional Awareness Program – Guest Lecture on Fundamental Rights







#### **Women Security Program – Candle March**

Date: 21/09/2019




Awareness among the youth by Blood Donation Camp












#### Student Literacy program – Visit to Ramakrishna Ashram Senior Secondary School





#### Narmada Seva- Cleanliness of river Narmada


#### Narmada National Youth Parliament – "Sustainable Future, Measures for Tomorrow"

## Poster, Essay, writing contest – Communal Harmony and Gandhian Preachings


Date: 19/11/2019 To 25/11/2019




#### Awareness program - Voters Day




#### Educational Visit – Parliament, New Delhi


#### **Awareness Program for Covid 19 in villages**
