
National training program on Intellectual Property Right






Quiz Competition, Group Discussion on Constitutional Day




Health Awareness Program for World AIDS Day






Online discussion and competition on Human Rights Day


Date: 10th December 2020






Webinar on Women's Empowerment




Speech Competition on International Day of Education


World Day of Social Justice Celebration


Earth Day Commemoration by NCC Cadets
