
National Conference on New Education Policy 2020











National E-Seminar on India's Independence






COVID-19 Vaccination Camp at St. Aloysius' College











Virtual Debate on Cyber Security at St. Aloysius College










Rose Plantation Drive at St. Aloysius' College











Equality Awareness Program for International Human RightsDay








Equality Awareness Program – Gender Equality





Awareness Program- Social Justice










Cleanliness Awareness Program: Swachhata Jagrukta Rally








World Earth Day – Collage-making Competition




