





Cleanliness Drive / Environment program


Date: 10th August 2023







Workshop on Drug-Free India




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Workshop on Voter's Day

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




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


Poster Competition on International Literacy Day









Quiz Competition on Electoral Literacy




Kavya Path on Mera Mati, Mera Desh


Health Awareness Program





Tagline Creation Competition- Election Festival , Pride of the Nation

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Short Video Making



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
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Inspirational Film, Stories telecast





Essay Competition

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




Oath Taking Ceremony







